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#### MILILANI TOWN ASSOCIATION BUDGET 2021-2022

The following is a budget for the upcoming fiscal year (April 1, 2021, through March 31, 2022) based on the Board of Directors' best estimate of the costs and expenses that will be incurred by the Association in the upcoming year in light of prior years' experience. The Association has historically minimized increases in membership assessments by using the Association's net income from other sources (e.g., cell phone tower rental income, event sponsorships, newsletter advertising) to defray part of the Association's expenses each year. As part of its financial practices and in order to protect against large unanticipated special assessments, the Association has also established and maintains capital reserves for repairs, replacements, improvements, etc. The Association's reserves are an essential part of maintaining home values in the Milliani Town and an important component of the Association's long-range planning. Before the beginning of each fiscal year, the members of the Association have resolved to treat as special assessments and capital contributions to the Association's capital reserves the amount of any excess revenues from membership assessments in the ensuing year, and these amounts have been added to the Association's capital reserves.

Now that we're a few weeks removed from 2020, it's a good time to reflect on such a momentous year. We can think about developments in the social and political spheres, but we also learned – or perhaps relearned – some valuable lessons about investing.

Here are four of them:

• A long-term perspective is essential. Volatility in the financial markets is nothing new, but, even so, 2020 was one for the books. Of course, the COVID-19 outbreak was the driving force behind most of the wild price swings. Soon after the pandemic's effects were first felt, the S&P 500, a common index of U.S. large-cap stocks, fell 34% but gained 67% by the end of the year. Consequently, investors who stuck with their investment port- folios and kept their eyes on their longterm goals, rather than on shocking headlines, ended up doing well. And while 2020 was obviously an unusual year, the long-term approach will always be valuable to investors.

#### · Investment opportunities are always available.

The pandemic drove down the prices of many stocks but it didn't necessarily harm the long-term fundamentals of these companies. In other words, they may still have had strong management, still produced desirable products and services, and still had good prospects for growth. In short, they may still have been good investment opportunities – and when their prices were depressed, they may also have been "bargains" for smart investors. And this is the case with virtually any market downturn – some high-quality stocks will be available at favorable prices.

- Diversification pays off. Bond prices often move in a different direction from stocks. So, during a period of volatility when stock prices are falling, such as we saw in the weeks after the pandemic hit in March, the presence of bonds in your portfolio can lessen the impact of the downturn and stabilize your overall returns. And this, in essence, is the value of maintaining a balanced and diversified portfolio. (Keep in mind, though, that diversification can't guarantee profits or prevent all losses.)
- The market looks ahead. The pandemic-driven market plunge may have been stunning, but it made a kind of intrinsic sense – after all, the sudden arrival of a pandemic that threatened lives, closed businesses and cost millions of jobs doesn't sound like a positive event for the financial markets. But the strong rally that followed the initial drop and continued into 2021 has surprised many people. After all, the pandemic's effects were felt throughout the rest of 2020, and are still being felt now, so why did stock prices rise? The answer is pretty straightforward: The financial markets always look ahead, not behind. And for a variety of reasons including widespread vaccinations, anticipated economic stimulus measures from Congress and the Biden administration, and the Federal Reserve's continued steps to keep interest rates low the markets are anticipating much stronger economic growth, possibly starting in the second half of 2021.

All of us are probably glad to have 2020 behind us. Yet, the year taught us some investment lessons that we can put to work in 2021 – and beyond.

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The MTA quarterly assessment is collected in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.02 of the Mililani Town DCCR. Assessment due dates are January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st in the amount of \$125.00 per quarter (effective April 1, 2020). Quarterly reminder notices are sent to homeowners. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of the month that payment is due.

#### THERE ARE 5 WAYS TO PAY YOUR ASSESSMENTS:

1. SurePay Payment Plan - SurePay allows your bank to automatically, electronically transfer your quarterly assessment payments from your checking or savings account through Automated Clearing House (ACH) to MTA. Fill out a SurePay form and turn it in to one of our business offices or send it to surepay@ mililanitown.org. Submit a voided check with your form.

- 2. Pay Online To safely pay your assessment online, homeowners must go through the official MTA website (www.mililanitown.org). Once on the official MTA home page, click on "Pay Assessments" in the top menu bar and you will be directed to the online payment page. Payments made through any other website is not recommended and are not guaranteed by MTA
- Pay in Person Payments may be made at the Rec Center 3 or 7 Business Offices during their regular business office hours. Please bring your remittance stub with you when you make your payment.
- Use Our Secure Drop-Box There is a drop-box located inside the administration office and is only available during regular business hours. (Currently Unavailable: please bring your payment to the Rec 3 or 7 Business Offices).
- 5. Pay by Mail To avoid late fees, please allow ample time for mail delivery and for your payments to post as received. Homeowners with multiple properties must submit a separate remittance stub and payment, for each property address.
- If you are mailing a check with the remittance stub, please mail it to: Mililani Town Association, P.O. Box 29380, Honolulu, HI 96820-1780. This is a "Lockbox" service through Bank of Hawaii. Only the payment will be processed.
- If you are mailing a check without the remittance stub or with the remittance stub and other correspondence or enclosures (such as name or mailing address changes), please mail it to:





In an effort to be proactive with our homeowners, MTA wants to inform everyone of the areas that are being inspected each month. The areas highlighted on this map are the areas scheduled for routine Covenant inspections for this month.

We hope to reduce the amount of violation letters we have to send out, by giving you an advance notice of where we will be. We are not trying to do our inspections in secret. We may be seen in an area that is NOT scheduled for a routine inspection. The reason is usually because we have a re-inspection, a complaint or a design project inspection in that area. Please remember, if you have any questions, please feel free to ask. We are very friendly and very willing to talk to you.





#### MTA COMMUNITY CORNER

Mililani has an extensive and loving dog community and is fortunate to have many areas to walk our canine members of the family to keep them healthy. MTA has many Oops! Stations set up around heavily used areas so that members can easily dispose of their dog's waste. These stations are cleaned and stocked with bags regularly to help keep Mililani clean and beautiful.



MTA has received complaints that people are tossing their poop bags into storm drains. While this is a county violation and subject to fines, it's important to keep in mind that storm drains are only designed to handle rain water runoff. Any debris (poop bags, lawn cuttings, leaves, etc.) go into our storm system and directly into the ocean. It does not pass through our sewer system to be cleaned.



#### **MEMBERSHIP POLICY**

To access MTA's Recreation Centers, participate in programs, classes and/or attend Special Events, members must obtain a valid MTA membership card.

The Owner listed on the property must submit an "Owner's Membership Information" form acknowledging that those listed are residing at the homeowner's property address.

The Member Services Department will be reviewing accounts. Proof of residency at the MTA property address may be required. An "Affidavit of Residency" will need to be signed in front of a Notary Public stating that the listed residents are permanently living with the Owner at the property address.

Misrepresentation of facts to obtain membership may result in the rescinding of MTA membership cards and/or suspension of privileges for the member(s) of the respective MTA property.



#### **MTA MEMBERSHIP CARDS**

Only one Member card is needed for your entire household. This will eliminate the need to purchase individual cards for everyone in your household.

No pictures or expiration date will be printed. A picture will still need to be taken for our RecTrac system only. At your convenience, please stop by any Recreation Center or Business Office to take your pictures.

New Card \$6.50 | 1 Year Renewal \$5 | Additional Cards \$2

**Don't forget a picture ID for verification.** You may also take a picture of the barcode on the back of the card with your phone in lieu of purchasing an additional card.

#### **MTA GUEST PASS**



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

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
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
