Last March, we were excited that the Department of Health and Times Supermarkets brought the Johnson and Johnson vaccines to Recreation Center 5. I hope you took advantage of the opportunity. As I mentioned in previous messages, I feel that this is our light at the end of the tunnel. While this virus may never go away, getting the vaccine makes sense as it relates to prevention and overall good health practices.

Each month I give a fair amount of thought as to what I will be writing about. I am always thoughtful about the personal content of my message and wonder if you would just rather hear about MTA business. This one will get personal and, you should know, I always

write with the intention of helping others.

As I mentioned in a previous message, my mother is suffering from Alzheimer's. We have known this for a little over a year now, but the symptoms are rapidly getting worse each week. Just last week she was telling me that she couldn't remember how to get dressed and she was upset because a strange man was trying to help her. This strange man was her husband. She temporarily forgot who he was. We know that it is only a matter of time before this is going to progress into her not being able to recognize anyone. Alzheimer patients have a fair long-term memory and very little short-term memory. This can explain why she is calling me every couple of days just to hear my voice and to remind me that I am her little boy. It's like holding onto a ribbon with a helium balloon of the end. Each time my grip loosens, the balloon slips a little further away. Soon it will be gone, and all I can do is watch it float away. I have also been extremely surprised with my dad. He has been so patient with her. I can only hope that I will have that level of love and understanding when I am his age. It's amazing to witness and it gives me some peace to know that, at the end of the day, all they have left is their love for each other and that is enough. Everything else is mostly meaningless. There is a huge life lesson there for me. There are some things that can be an irritation or sources of frustration, but if you have someone to love and they love you back, no matter what, that can sustain you. I know my physical time with my parents is coming to an end. It is my goal to be in every moment I can with them and to cherish the time we can spend together before it is gone.

On March 17, 2021, the Mililani Town Association and the current Board of Directors gathered for the 53rd Annual Meeting at Recreation Center 3.

President Robert Barrett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. It was ascertained that there were more than 100 votes represented in person and by proxy establishing a quorum for the meeting. The total count of proxy votes represented was 2,946.

The 2020 Annual Meeting minutes were approved. Each Department's year-end reports and the current financial report were also presented. The resolution respecting capital contributions for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2022 was adopted. The resolution for establishing a Board of Directors of 9 members for the fiscal year April 1, 2022 to March 31, 2023 was adopted.

#### HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS

The MTA quarterly assessment is collected in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.02 of the Mililani Town DCCR. Assessment due dates are January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st in the amount of \$125.00 per quarter (effective April 1, 2020). Quarterly reminder notices are sent to homeowners. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of the month that payment is due.

#### THERE ARE 5 WAYS TO PAY YOUR ASSESSMENTS:

1. SurePay Payment Plan - SurePay allows your bank to automatically, electronically transfer your quarterly assessment payments from your checking or savings account through Automated Clearing House (ACH) to MTA. Fill out a SurePay form and turn it in to one of our business offices or send it to surepay@ mililanitown.org. Submit a voided check with your form.

- 2. Pay Online To safely pay your assessment online, homeowners must go through the official MTA website (www.mililanitown.org). Once on the official MTA home page, click on "Pay Assessments" in the top menu bar and you will be directed to the online payment page. Payments made through any other website is not recommended and are not guaranteed by MTA
- Pay in Person Payments may be made at the Rec Center 3 or 7 Business Offices during their regular business office hours. Please bring your remittance stub with you when you make your payment.
- Use Our Secure Drop-Box There is a drop-box located inside the administration office and is only available during regular business hours. (Currently Unavailable: please bring your payment to the Rec 3 or 7 Business Offices).
- 5. Pay by Mail To avoid late fees, please allow ample time for mail delivery and for your payments to post as received. Homeowners with multiple properties must submit a separate remittance stub and payment, for each property address.
- If you are mailing a check with the remittance stub, please mail it to: Mililani Town Association, P.O. Box 29380, Honolulu, HI 96820-1780. This is a "Lockbox" service through Bank of Hawaii. Only the payment will be processed.
- If you are mailing a check without the remittance stub or with the remittance stub and other correspondence or enclosures (such as name or mailing address changes), please mail it to:

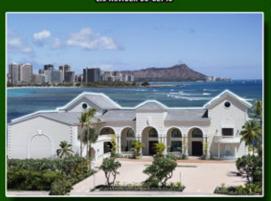

If you're planning to retire in just a few years, you may be getting excited about this next phase of your life. However, your ability to enjoy retirement fully will depend, at least partially, on the resources you can draw from your investment portfolio. So, while you still have time to act, ask yourself if you're comfortable with your

Your relationship with risk can change noticeably over time. When you started saving for retirement, you may have been willing to take on more investment risk, which translated into a relatively high percentage of stocks and stock-based mutual funds in your investment portfolio. As you know, stocks offer the potential for greater returns than other assets - such as bonds and certificates of deposit (CDs) - but they are also typically more volatile and carry more risk. But when you were many decades away from retirement, you had sufficient time to recover from market fluctuations. (Of course, there are no guarantees - it's possible that some stocks will lose value and never regain it.)

Now, fast forward to where you are now - closing in on retirement. Even at this stage of your life - and, in fact, even during your retirement - you will need some growth-oriented investments to help stay ahead of inflation. Over time, even a low inflation rate, such as we've had the past several years, can erode your purchasing power.

So, the issue isn't this: "Should I get rid of all my risk?" You shouldn't - and, in fact, you couldn't, because all investments, even the ones considered most "conservative," contain some type of risk, even if it isn't the risk of loss of principal. For instance, some investments run the risk of not keeping up with inflation. Instead, ask yourself these questions: "How much risk should I take within my portfolio?" "How much risk do I actually need to achieve my goals in retirement?"

Of course, there are no one-size-fits-all answers. You'll need to look at your investment portfolio to see if it's positioned to provide you with the income you'll require in your retirement years. You might have initially based your financial strategy on a specific type of retirement lifestyle, but now that you're nearing retirement, perhaps you've changed your mind. Your anticipated new lifestyle. might require either more or less income than you had originally projected - and if that's the case, you may need to adjust the risk level in your portfolio or make other

For example, suppose you had initially envisioned a rather quiet retirement, sticking around your home, volunteering and spending time with your grandchildren.

- and especially since the confinement many of us have felt during the COVID-19 pandemic
- -you may have thought that you'd now like to travel extensively. To achieve this goal, which will

likely cost more than your original one, you may have to work longer, or invest more each year until you retire, or seek a higher return on your investments - which means accepting more risk.

As you can see, managing risk is a balancing act - and you may need to make some tough choices. But as long as you're aware of how much risk you can take, and how much risk you may need to take to reach your goals, you can develop a strategy that aligns with your objectives.

#### FOR YOUR SAFETY: PLEASE WALK & RUN ON THE SIDEWALK

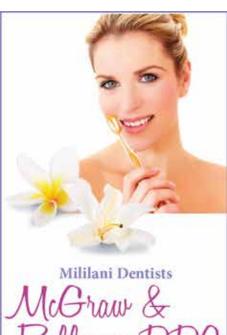
We are fortunate to have beautiful landscaping and clean and safe sidewalks in Mililani. Please be safe and take advantage of the sidewalks instead of walking, running or playing on the roadways.

The Pedestrian law 291C-76(a) states: (1) Where sidewalks are provided, it is unlawful for any pedestrian to walk along and upon adjacent roadway, bicycle lane, or bicycle path. (2) Where sidewalks are not provided, pedestrians walking along and upon any roadway, when practical, walk only on the left side of the roadway or it's shoulder facing traffic from the opposite direction.

- DON'T WEAR HEADPHONES AND ALWAYS STAY AWARE OF WHAT'S HAPPENING AROUND YOU.

#### **MEMBERSHIP POLICY**

To access MTA's Recreation Centers, participate in programs, classes and/or attend Special Events, members must obtain a valid MTA membership card.

The Owner listed on the property must submit an "Owner's Membership Information" form acknowledging that those listed are residing at the homeowner's property address.

The Member Services Department will be reviewing accounts. Proof of residency at the MTA property address may be required. An "Affidavit of Residency" will need to be signed in front of a Notary Public stating that the listed residents are permanently living with the Owner at the property address.

Misrepresentation of facts to obtain membership may result in the rescinding of MTA membership cards and/or suspension of privileges for the member(s) of the respective MTA property.



#### **MTA MEMBERSHIP CARDS**

Only one Member card is needed for your entire household. This will eliminate the need to purchase individual cards for everyone in your household.

No pictures or expiration date will be printed. A picture will still need to be taken for our RecTrac system only. At your convenience, please stop by any Recreation Center or Business Office to take your pictures.

#### MTA MEMBERSHIP ID CARD FEES:

New Card \$6.50 | 1 Year Renewal \$5 | Additional Cards \$2

**Don't forget a picture ID for verification.** You may also take a picture of the barcode on the back of the card with your phone in lieu of purchasing an additional card.

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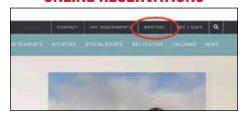
