

### HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS

The MTA guarterly assessment is collected in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.02 of the Mililani Town DCCR. Assessment due dates are January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st in the amount of \$125.00 per quarter (effective April 1, 2020). Quarterly reminder notices are sent to homeowners. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of the month that payment is due.

### THERE ARE 5 WAYS TO PAY YOUR ASSESSMENTS:

1. SurePay Payment Plan - SurePay allows your bank to automatically, electronically transfer your quarterly assessment payments from your checking or savings account through Automated Clearing House (ACH) to MTA. Fill out a SurePay form and turn it in to one of our business offices or send it to surepay@ mililanitown.org. Submit a voided check with your form.

2. Pay Online - To safely pay your assessment online, homeowners must go through the official MTA website (www.mililanitown. org). Once on the official MTA home page, click on "Pay Assessments" in the top menu bar and you will be directed to the online payment page. Payments made through any other website is not recommended and are not guaranteed by MTA.

- 3. Pay in Person Payments may be made at the Rec Center 3 or 7 Business Offices during their regular business office hours. Please bring your remittance stub with you when you make your payment.
- 4. Use Our Secure Drop-Box There is a drop-box located inside the administration office and is only available during regular business hours. (Currently Unavailable: please bring your payment to the Rec 3 or 7 Business Offices).
- 5. Pay by Mail To avoid late fees, please allow ample time for mail delivery and for your payments to post as received. Homeowners with multiple properties must submit a separate remittance stub and payment, for each property address.
- If you are mailing a check with the remittance stub, please mail it to: Mililani Town Association, P.O. Box 29380, Honolulu, HI 96820-1780. This is a "Lockbox" service through Bank of Hawaii. Only the payment will be processed.

### MTA COMMON AREA TREES

Mililani Town is blessed with an abundance of trees in its common areas. Several different species of trees highlight the landscape through out Mililani Town and as a result, Mililani Town was recently awarded a Tree City USA certification.

Maintaining trees in an urban environment requires special practices, especially with well established trees. Pruning practices, root development, replanting, etc. must all be taken into consideration when maintaining urban trees. Mililani Town has an abundance of mature trees. Certain trees originally planted adjacent to sidewalks have lifted slabs creating potential trip hazards. Removing the roots to eliminate the trip hazard will jeopardize the stability of the tree. Roots have two basic functions; stability and nutrient uptake. When roots are removed close to the trunk of a mature tree it can increase the chance of a complete failure. To eliminate this potential hazard, complete removal and replanting is a practical option.

The Norfolk pines that Mililani is well known for are able to grow in a wide range of soil conditions. They have a shallow root system that may damage sidewalks and foundations when planted too close. This condition can be seen at the corner of Kaapeha and Meheula parkway in Mililani Mauka. As the trees matured its roots lifted the walkway creating a potential trip hazard. Although root pruning is a common arboricultural practice, trimming anchoring roots too close to the trunk may contribute to the tree's ultimate failure. The complete removal and replanting of the tree is a better option.

MTA will remove the pines in October 2021 and replant the corner with trees and shrubs better suited given the limited planting space. Replanting Norfolk Pines in the same area will create future issues. MTA will consider other species of trees that will add to the overall Mililani experience and still maintain the aesthetics of the corner planter.

MTA is dedicated maintaining the Landscaping of Mililani Town, and its trees play an important role in its design intent.







# WEBTRAC 101: LEARN HOW TO NAVIGATE WEBTRAC FASTER & EASIER!

### WHAT IS WEBTRAC?

WebTrac is a system that will enable you to register you and your household members on-line for programs and activities offered by Mililani Town Association.

But when a trust company serves as trustee, it impartially administers distribution of the assets based on the instructions you've provided in the trust - helping minimize family disputes over inheritances. If you ever feel like the complexities of wealth management and trust administration are getting to be more than you can handle - or perhaps more than you want to handle consider contacting a trust company. You might find that it can make your life a lot easier.
