

HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS

The MTA quarterly assessment is collected in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.02 of the Mililani Town DCCR. Assessment due dates are January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st in the amount of \$125.00 per quarter (effective April 1, 2020). Quarterly reminder notices are sent to homeowners. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of the month that payment is due.

THERE ARE 5 WAYS TO PAY YOUR ASSESSMENTS:

 SurePay Payment Plan - SurePay allows your bank to automatically, electronically transfer your quarterly assessment payments from your checking or savings account through Automated Clearing House (ACH) to MTA. Fill out a SurePay form and turn it in to one of our business offices or send it to surepay@ mililanitown.org. Submit a voided check with your form.

- 2. Pay Online To safely pay your assessment online, homeowners must go through the official MTA website (www.mililanitown.org). - 3. Pay in Person Payments may be made at the Rec Center 3 or 7 Business Offices during their regular business office hours. Please bring your remittance stub with you when you make your payment.
- Use Our Secure Drop-Box There is a drop-box located inside the administration office and is only available during regular business hours. (Currently Unavailable: please bring your payment to the Rec 3 or 7 Business Offices).




MONTHLY COVENANTS INSPECTIONS

ROTARY CLUB CELEBRATES 25TH ANNIVERSARY

Rotary is the world's premier international humanitarian service organization. We are a diverse global network of community, business, and professional leaders who address relevant social causes to change lives and build goodwill and peace at home and abroad.

We work with the World Health Organization, UNICEF, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, and national governments toward our top goal of eradicating polio worldwide.

We also focus our time, energy, and efforts on service projects encompassing:

- Disease prevention and treatment
- Water and sanitation
- Economic and community development

Rotary, People of Action – Community Service We base our service projects around Rotary International's areas of focus. RCMS has been involved in many community-service projects, some with our Interact partner. An Interact Club is the high school version of a Rotary Club. Mililani Sunrise sponsors an Interact Club at Mililani High School. Some of the notable service projects are feeding the homeless at Institute for Human Services, Friends of Mililani Library Booksale, Quest for Success at Mililani High School, Salvation Army bell ringing during the holiday seasons, involving seniors at the Plaza doing various arts and crafts, and Keiki Vision, an eye screening process for 3rd grade students at six elementary schools in Mililani.

However, due to COVID protocol, several projects have been temporarily paused.

In November 2020, we thanked 1200 teachers and school staffs with masks that say, "School Superhero", accompanied with ear savers, by raising \$5000. Most recently, in June, members participated in the Mokuleia Beach cleanup and tree planting at the Gun Stock Ranch. On July 3, 10, 17, 24, RCMS assisted the C&C with Kaukau4Keiki

Food Distribution in the MHS parking lot. On each Saturday, 140 boxes of food were distributed to families who had previously signed up for food assistance. A \$50 box of food was distributed to each child. Our annual school supply drive was held on July 17, 18 at the Town Center of Mililani fronting Longs; we were able to collect 52 boxes of school supplies and over \$2500 in cash donations. August was Pedestrian Safety month, RCMS assisted Town Center of Mililani and the Wahiawa PD, by waving signs near Ruby Tuesday, a crucial intersection in the community, educating pedestrians and motorists of pedestrian safety.

However, the most rewarding community service project was the 21 scholarship golf tournaments hosted by RCMS. The golf tournaments provided 226 graduating seniors with \$377,000 in scholarship grants! In addition, 43 scholars sponsored by RCMS, received scholarships totaling \$159,000, from the Hawaii Rotary Youth Foundation. We are committed to tomorrow's leaders!

Mililani Sunrise has also been involved with international service projects and matching grants. Post-World War II, Sgt. Hugh O'Reilly, while touring Osaka, Japan, witnessed the poor living conditions of orphans. Subsequently,



the 27th Infantry, Wolfhounds, "adopted" the Holy Family Home orphanage and donated their time and money. The Wolfhounds, a Battalion at Schofield, continues to support the orphanage to present day. Since 1998, RCMS has supported the Wolfhounds and Peace Bridge, a 501(c)3, by purchasing and donating toys to the orphanage during the Christmas holidays. The toys are hand-delivered to Holy Family Home by Wolfhounds.



Mililani Sunrise also participated with the Rotary Club of Manila Bay, our sister club, in The Rotary Foundation Matching Grant program. The purpose of the grant was to build water systems in 27 barangays, including 5 schools, in the Province of Quezon, Philippines, providing clean and potable water. (Barangays are small communities within a town; and many towns make up a province.) Consumption of polluted water is the #1 killer of children in the Philippines. The water wells benefitted 9,939 residents in the barangays and schools. Through TRF grants, RCMS was able to raise the Philippine Pesos 728,245, (\$17,790, with exchange rate of PhP 40.0 = 1 USD), to finance this water project.

With only 12 members, RCMS is considered a small club; however, we are committed to grow the club by 50% in this Rotary year. We welcome anyone interested in doing community service and connecting with other like-minded community members, to email President, Paul Nakachi, at exlender808@outlook.com.

To commemorate our 25 years of service, RCMS will be donating a Peace Pole to the Mililani community. A Peace Pole is an internationally recognized symbol of the hopes and dreams of the entire human family, standing vigil in silent prayer for peace on earth. Each Peace Pole bears the message May Peace Prevail on Earth in different languages on each of its four sides. There are estimated over 250,000 Peace Pole in every country in the world dedicated as monuments to peace.
