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HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS

The MTA quarterly assessment is collected in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.02 of the Mililani Town DCCR. Assessment due dates are January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st in the amount of \$125.00 per quarter (effective April 1, 2020). Quarterly reminder notices are sent to homeowners. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of the month that payment is due.

THERE ARE 5 WAYS TO PAY YOUR ASSESSMENTS:

 SurePay Payment Plan - SurePay allows your bank to automatically, electronically transfer your quarterly assessment payments from your checking or savings account through Automated Clearing House (ACH) to MTA. Fill out a SurePay form and turn it in to one of our business offices or send it to surepay@ mililanitown.org. Submit a voided check with your form.

- 2. Pay Online To safely pay your assessment online, homeowners must go through the official MTA website (www.mililanitown.org). Once on the official MTA home page, click on "Pay Assessments" in the top menu bar and you will be directed to the online payment page. Payments made through any other website is not recommended and are not guaranteed by MTA.
- 3. Pay in Person Payments may be made at the Rec Center 3 or 7 Business Offices during their regular business office hours. Please bring your remittance stub with you when you make your payment.
- Use Our Secure Drop-Box There is a drop-box located inside the administration office and is only available during regular business hours. (Currently Unavailable: please bring your payment to the Rec 3 or 7 Business Offices).
- 5. Pay by Mail To avoid late fees, please allow ample time for mail delivery and for your

For this upcoming fiscal year beginning April 1, 2022, there are four director positions open, three for 3 years and one for 2 years. The election will be held through mail-in ballots. Prospective candidates should be oriented toward serving the interests of the Mililani Town Association and have the time and energy to attend monthly board meetings. To be eligible to serve on the MTA Board of Directors, current law requires all candidates to be members of the Association (owners) and no more than one owner from the same unit may serve on the Board at the same time.

Members interested in running for one of the four positions may pick up a Board of Directors Candidate Application at MTA's Recreation Center 3 Business Office, 95-281 Kaloapau Street, during normal business hours, daily from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. (except holidays) or download the application by visiting the MTA website at www.mililanitown.org. If you prefer to have an application mailed to you, you may call 440-2625.

The deadline for filing candidate applications is 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, December 14, 2021. Results of the election will be announced at the 54th Annual Meeting to be held on Wednesday, March 16, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. at Recreation Center 3.




MONTHLY COVENANTS INSPECTIONS

If you're going to retire in the next few years, you'll want to start thinking about making some changes to your investment portfolio. And one area you may want to look at is whatever type of cash account you might have – because, when you're retired, the amount of cash you have readily available may be even more important than when you were working. Your cash management account could pay a slightly higher rate than a typical savings account, as well as serving as a holding place for funds that may eventually be transferred to other investments. Furthermore, it can provide you with these benefits:

• You can pay for emergency expenses. You might be retired, but life goes on – and life is full of unexpected expenses, such as a new furnace or a costly auto repair. It's a good idea for retirees to keep at least three months of living expenses in a separate cash account, which can help pay for emergencies without forcing you to dip into your longer-term investments.

 You can save for a short-term goal. You may have several short-term goals, such as a long vacation or a kitchen remodeling project. If you are trying to reach this type of goal within a year or two, you may want to start moving funds into your cash management account. For goals with longer time frames, you may want to consider using other types of investments appropriate for the specific goal and your risk tolerance.

· You can protect some money from market volatility. When you're a long way from retirement, you may not be particularly bothered when the financial markets drop, leading to a decline in the value of your investment portfolio. However, once you're retired, those downturns might not be quite so tolerable. As a retiree, you may want to maintain one year of expenses (adjusted for outside income sources such as Social Security) in a cash management account for spending purposes. Knowing you have this cash set aside may help you feel more comfortable when markets are volatile. Nevertheless, holding too much cash has risks of its own. Retirement can last for more than 30 years, so you'll want to be invested in enough equities and fixed-income vehicles to provide your portfolio with the balance and growth potential necessary to help you avoid outliving your money.

As you can see, building your cash management account can be helpful in several ways. So, in the years preceding your retirement, look for opportunities to add to this account. For example, you could use some of the money from a tax refund or a borus at work. And, if you haven't already done so, you might direct your bank to move a certain amount each month from your checking or savings account into your cash management. When you're retired, do what you can to replenish your cash account as much as possible.

Your cash management account is important at every point in your life, but it may take on even greater meaning when you're retired – so do whatever you can to keep it in good shape.

FOR YOUR SAFETY: Please walk & Run on the sidewalk

We are fortunate to have beautiful landscaping and clean and safe sidewalks in Mililani. Please be safe and take advantage of the sidewalks instead of walking, running or playing on the roadways.

IT'S THE LAW:

The Pedestrian law 291C-76(a) states: (1) Where sidewalks are provided, it is unlawful for any pedestrian to walk along and upon adjacent roadway, bicycle lane, or bicycle path. (2) Where sidewalks are not provided, pedestrians walking along and upon any roadway, when practical, walk only on the left side of the roadway or it's shoulder facing traffic from the opposite direction.

SAFETY TIPS

FROM THE ROAD RUNNERS CLUB OF AMERICA:

• DON'T WEAR HEADPHONES AND ALWAYS STAY AWARE OF WHAT'S HAPPENING AROUND YOU.

• OBEY TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SIGNALS AND Look Both Ways Before Crossing at a cross walk.

> • WEAR REFLECTIVE MATERIAL or light colored clothes if you must run before dawn or after dark.
