HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS

The MTA quarterly assessment is collected in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.02 of the Mililani Town DCCR. Assessment due dates are January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st in the amount of \$145.00 per quarter (effective April 1, 2022). Quarterly reminder notices are sent to homeowners. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of the month that payment is due.

THERE ARE 5 WAYS TO PAY YOUR ASSESSMENTS:

 SurePay Payment Plan - SurePay allows your bank to automatically, electronically transfer your quarterly assessment payments from your checking or savings account through Automated Clearing House (ACH) to MTA. Fill out a SurePay form and turn it in to one of our business offices or send it to surepay@ mililanitown.org. Submit a voided check with your form.

- 2. Pay Online To safely pay your assessment online, homeowners must go through the official MTA website (www.mililanitown.org). Once on the official MTA home page, click on "Pay Assessments" in the top menu bar and you will be directed to the online payment page. Payments made through any other website is not recommended and are not guaranteed by MTA
- 3. Pay in Person Payments may be made at the Admin Office, Rec Center 3 or 7 Business Offices during their regular business office hours. Please bring your remittance stub with you when you make your payment.
- Use Our Secure Drop-Box There is a drop-box located inside the administration office and is only available during regular business hours.
- Pay by Mail To avoid late fees, please allow ample time for mail delivery and for your payments to post as received. Homeowners with multiple properties must submit a

separate remittance stub and payment, for each property address.

- If you are mailing a check with the remittance stub, please mail it to: Mililani Town Association, P.O. Box 29380, Honolulu, HI 96820-1780. This is a "Lockbox" service through Bank of Hawaii. Only the payment will be processed.

To terminate SurePay, I understand that I must complete and submit the SurePay Cancellation form to Mililani Town Association by the 28th of the preceding month to terminate services for the upcoming quarter. If it is received after the 28th, SurePay will be terminated on the next payment cycle. (Ex. Due 12/28/2021 for 1/1/2022 quarterly assessments)



CANDIDATES WANTED FOR MTA BOARD

The Association is seeking diligent and enthusiastic candidates to fill the vacancies on the MTA Board of Directors. For this upcoming fiscal year beginning April 1, 2023, there are four director positions open, three for a 3-year term and one for a 1-year term. The election will be held through mail-in ballots. Prospective candidates should be oriented toward serving the interests of the Mililani Town Association and have the time and energy to attend monthly board meetings. To be eligible to serve on the MTA Board of Directors, current law requires all candidates to be members of the Association (owners) and no more than one owner from the same unit may serve on the Board at the same time.

Members interested in running for one of the four positions may pick up a Board of Directors Candidate Application at MTA's Administrative Office, 95-303 Kaloapau Street, during normal business hours, Monday-Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (except holidays) or download the application by visiting the MTA website at www.mililanitown.org. If you prefer to have an application mailed to you, you may call (808) 440-2625.

The deadline for filing candidate applications is 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, December 13, 2022. Results of the election will be announced at the 55th Annual Meeting to be held on Wednesday, March 15, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. at Recreation Center 3.


MONTHLY COVENANTS INSPECTIONS

RULES AND ENFORCEMENT AT OUR FACILITIES

Parents and Guardians, we need your help. We have seen an increase of our MTA staff issuing warnings to school aged members at our recreation centers. Warnings include use of profane language, bullying other members, running and screaming in the facilities, not cleaning up after themselves (example: leaving empty saimin bowls and drinks in the facility), abuse of MTA recreation equipment, rough-housing and "bombing" in the pools. MTA staff are instructed to give two warnings. The third warning will result in being ejected from the premises and parents being called. This is a daily routine for MTA staff, especially at Recreation Center 7.

Parents/Guardians: Please speak to your children when sending them or dropping them off at the facilities.

Per the Mililani Town Rules

Section C-8: "Any person using the facilities agrees to abide by the MILILANI TOWN RULES and instructions of MTA Staff on duty as a condition of remaining on the premises."

Section J-1: "Violation of any of the MILILANI TOWN RULES while using any of the Mililani Recreation Centers will result in two verbal warnings before being ejected from the premises. The individual will be refused Recreation Center use privileges for a period of 48 hours. Any activity that is dangerous to an individual or others and/or illegal will not require any warning and will result in immediate ejection from the premises. (If the individual refuses to vacate the premises as requested, HPD will be summoned, and the violator charged with 'trespassing')".

Section J-4: "Any repetition of the same violation will not require warning before being ejected from the premises. Additional penalties imposed may be more severe including, but not limited to, suspension of all privileges for a longer period as determined by the General Manager".

The crew got there early to set up their booth which featured the "Spaghetti Marshmallow Challenge", an activity where kids must build a tower made out of raw spaghetti noodles and place a marshmallow on top.
