## MESSAGES FROM ELECTED OFFICIALS

### A Message From SENATOR DONOVAN M. DELA CRUZ

#### Mililani Legislative Updates

- School Facilities Authority (SFA) Teacher Housing - HB329
  - Appropriates funds to allow the SFA to partner with public and private development agencies to develop prekindergarten, preschool, childcare, and early learning program facilities
    - \$2 million was appropriated for the fiscal year 2025-2026 for planning and construction for workforce housing at Mililani High School
- Landfill Bill - HB969
  - The legislature passed HB969 to prohibit landfills over Class A agricultural lands & prevent development of a landfill mauka of the Underground Injection Control (UIC) line, protecting Hawaii's water resources & preserving Central Oahu's agricultural land Wahiawa.
- Kamehameha Highway Improvements (CIP)
  - Appropriates \$18.6 million for improvements to Kamehameha Highway between Mililani and Pearl City in FY26
- Stabilizing Property Insurance - SB1044
  - This bill creates a loan program for condominiums addresses the deferred maintenance issues costs and expands Hawai'i Property Insurance Association (HPIA) and Hawai'i Hurricane Relief Fund (HHRF) to help condo owners who are unable to get insurance on the open market

#### Key Investments in Agricultural Innovation

Investments in infrastructure & facilities in Central Oahu help boost local food production, reduce dependency on imports & strengthen Central Oahu's economic resilience. Here are some highlights of strategic investments that the legislature made this year:

- 1.00 position & \$2.14M in FY26 & FY27 for strategic coordination to support local farmers
- \$13.2 million in FY26 for irrigation systems to support agricultural production in Central Oahu
- \$30,450,000 in FY26 and \$650,000 in FY27 are being invested in food processing facilities on Oahu
- \$650,000 in FY26 and \$16,500,000 in FY27 for statewide expansion of the regional kitchen model
- \$14,450,000 in FY26 that can be used for agricultural land acquisition. This will ensure that we can protect Hawai'i agricultural future. It preserves space for farming, safeguards our local food supply, and creates long-term opportunities for the next generation of farmers to thrive

#### General Legislative Updates

- Illegal Firework - SB222 and SB1324:
  - SB222 continues funding for Illegal Firework Taskforce. And extends the Illegal Firework Task Force to June 30, 2020. The Illegal Firework Taskforce was created to address the escalating issue of illegal explosives and improve public safety. Since its establishment in 2023, the task force has seized over 227,000 pounds of illegal fireworks. This bill will ensure that the task force can continue its vital work in combating illegal fireworks.
    - \$1.27M in FY26 & \$1.16M in FY27 for the extension of the Illegal Fireworks Task Force.
  - SB1324 creates and increases penalties for illegal fireworks to match the increasing risk that illegal fireworks pose to our communities.
- Pearl Highlands Park and Ride - SB934
  - The City and County of Honolulu have requested an increase

in the Mass Transit Special Funding ceiling of \$427,305,000 due to more funds coming into the special fund than originally anticipated. SB934 requires the C&C of Honolulu to move forward with the development of the Pearl Highlands Park and ride facility, as originally proposed to the residents of Oahu back in 2015 as a condition of accessing the additional funding ceiling. The park and ride is essential to providing access for central Oahu residents looking to access Skyline.

- Guidelines for Electric Bicycles - HB958
  - Establishes new safe riding guidelines for electric bicycles. Implementation of required labeling for electric bicycles. Redefines "low-speed electric bicycle" to just "electric bicycle". The same regulations as electric foot scooters now apply to electric micro-mobility devices. The law layouts age guidelines for operating different classes of electric bikes. Prohibits a person from riding a class 3, the highest class, electric bicycle on a sidewalk. Requires persons under the age of eighteen to wear a helmet while riding a bicycle or electric foot scooter. HB958 also repeals the requirement that moped drivers use bicycle lanes.
- School Meals - SB1300
  - Beginning with 2025-2026 school year SB1300 appropriates \$565,000 in FY26 and \$2,800,000 in FY27 for the expansion of free school meals for public school students from low-income working families. SB1300 will provide free school meals to students who currently qualify for reduced-price lunch and expand free school meal coverage to students whose family income is not more than 300% per cent of the federal poverty level. This will ensure proper nutrition for all of Hawai'i's students regardless of socioeconomic status.
- Hele Imua Internships- HB 430SB 327
  - This bill expands the existing Hele Imua internship program that allows residents to take part in paid internships with private businesses in the state. Funded by the Legislature in 2022, Hele Imua provides opportunities for people to gain valuable work-based experience and support themselves and their families. Workforce development programs like Hele Imua are critical to reversing the brain drain and keeping residents employed in Hawai'i.

### A Message From SENATOR MICHELLE KIDANI

Our 2025 Legislative Session has officially wrapped up and here are several key initiatives which I helped to pass. If signed into law, the funding could bring meaningful change to classrooms and student experiences across our state.

**SB1300 SD1 HD1 CD1**, relating to school meals: beginning with the 2025–2026 school year, thousands of students across the state who currently qualify for reduced-price lunches will receive free school meals. This will expand upon the federal free meals subsidy by providing free meals for approximately 34,000 Hawai'i students over the next two years. Additionally, in the 2026–2027 school year, the program will expand further to include students from families earning up to 300% of the federal poverty level. This would ensure more students being able to focus on learning without the barrier of hunger or financial hardships, at a cost of \$2.8 million.

**HB300 HD1 SD1 CD1**, relating to the state budget - includes significant funding to advance key priorities within the Department of Education. These targeted investments will



support innovative learning, promote gender equity in athletics, and strengthen connections between schools and local communities.

• **Ho'ākea Program – \$4 million in FY26 and FY27**

This funding supports the continuation and expansion of the Ho'ākea Program, a unique partnership with the Polynesian Voyaging Society. The program engages students in hands-on learning grounded in Native Hawaiian culture - deepening cultural understanding while promoting STEM skills and leadership.

• **Girls Flag Football – \$726,100 reoccurring funds**

This appropriation marks a meaningful step forward in advancing gender equity in school athletics and expanding opportunities for student engagement and development by officially recognizing girls flag football as a DOE sport. This inaugural year, 46 schools participated, making Hawai'i the 12th state to sanction girls flag football as a high school sport.

• **Public Pre-Kindergarten Learning - \$12.2 million**

This money will ensure all children eligible for preschool have access to high-quality early learning opportunities.

• **Mathematics and Financial Literacy - \$927,248 and 6 positions**

This expands curriculum initiatives and for instructional support for classroom teachers.

I also had the pleasure of participating in several community events! One such event was the 50th anniversary celebration of Mililani Uka Elementary School, marking half a century of educating and empowering generations of students. Since its founding, the school has distinguished itself through strong academic performance and meaningful community engagement. In support of continued excellence at Mililani Uka, I am pleased to share that \$1.5 million I requested has been released for telecommunications upgrades. These funds will support the design, construction, and renovation of critical safety for telecom infrastructure.

It was a privilege to attend the 3rd Annual Culinary Showcase at Mililani High School. This event opens the doors of the MHS Culinary Program to the public, offering a behind-the-scenes look at the awesome skills students are developing. The showcase also shines a light on the school's ongoing partnerships with local industry leaders, including The Clubhouse Mililani and Mari's Garden. MHS Culinary students prepared and presented dishes that were quite ono and demonstrated both creativity and professionalism.

Mililani High School has once again demonstrated its strength and spirit in athletics, proudly bringing home another State Championship title! In a thrilling Girls Softball Championship game, Mililani faced off against Maryknoll in a 10-7 fierce and competitive matchup.

Congratulations also go to the inaugural Mililani Girls Flag Football team for earning an impressive 3rd place in the Hawai'i High School Athletic Association (HHSAA). We are incredibly proud of all our Mililani Trojans—your hard work and determination continue to inspire. GO TROJANS!

The Kipapa Elementary School Drama Club's fantastic performance of *SpongeBob!* was a true celebration of talent and creativity and a joyful reminder of the power of the arts in education. I encourage all students to explore their passions

and to embrace every opportunity to learn, grow, and express themselves. Mahalo also to our extraordinary teachers who help our keiki explore their talent!

During the summer months, I remain dedicated to supporting thoughtful progress in our public education system, culture, and community, and creating lasting learning opportunities for our youth. Mahalo for staying engaged and informed and I hope that you and your families have a very safe and restful summer!

**A Message From  
REPRESENTATIVE TRISH LA CHICA**

Dear Mililani Neighbors,

Mahalo once again for the opportunity to serve our community as your State Representative, representing the beautiful communities of District 37.

**2025 Legislative Session Highlights.** This year, I stepped into a new leadership role as Assistant Majority Floor Leader, while continuing in my second year as Vice Chair of the House Committee on Education, focusing on issues that impact our keiki's future, health, and safety.

This session, I introduced 28 bills and 5 resolutions - many shaped by your stories and feedback. Here are a few that passed and are awaiting Governor's signature (as of 5/19):

• **HB862 – Fixing the School Bus Crisis**

Allows the use of motorcoaches, small buses, and vans to transport students more efficiently and helps address the school bus driver shortage that has affected too many families.

• **HB1231 – Safer Routes to School**

Establishes Hawai'i's largest dedicated funding source for the Safe Routes to School program, bringing raised crosswalks and rapid flashing beacons to our most high-risk areas.

• **HB329 – Expanding Preschool Access & Teacher Housing**

Enables the School Facilities Authority to develop more preschool classrooms and workforce housing statewide - including a new teacher housing pilot project at Mililani High School.

• **SB1300 – Free School Meals**

While I didn't author this bill, I played a key role in negotiating its passage. SB1300 is one of the most meaningful education bills we passed out of the legislature this year. Starting next school year, students on reduced-price lunch will receive meals for free. The following year, the program expands to families earning up to 300% of the federal poverty level.

**Investments for Our District.** Your voices helped shape this year's budget. We secured over \$21 million in funding for Central Oahu, including:

• **\$18.6M for Kamehameha Highway improvements between Mililani and Pearl City.**

• **\$1.85M for barriers and signage near Kipapa Gulch to enhance safety and prevent unauthorized encampments.**

• **\$800,000 for Wahiawā Center for Community Health's pediatric clinic renovations and operational support for primary care, mental health services, substance use treatment, and social services.** Wahiawā CHC serves Waipahu, Mililani, Wahiawā, and Waialua.

• **\$400,000 to renovate the bathrooms at the Hawai'i Okinawa**

Center.

• **\$100,000 for 'Ōhāna Arts to support performances of the *Peace On Your Wings* musical in Honolulu, Fukuoka, and Hiroshima.**

**New Facilities for our Schools.** We celebrated several exciting new facility additions for our keiki this year. Mahalo to my fellow area legislators for helping make these projects possible!

• **The beautiful Rainbow Lanai and two new portable classrooms at Kanoelani Elementary School**

• **A covered playcourt with retractable basketball hoops at Mililani Mauka Elementary School**

• **A freight farm (an innovative vertical farming system inside a shipping container) and an upgraded softball field with state-of-the-art turf at Mililani High School.**

**Community Events.** This year, I've continued to bring neighbors together and invited policy experts to our district to address pressing issues. We've talked story about road safety, fireworks enforcement, housing and condo insurance, and we've shown up for cleanups, Drive with Aloha sign-waving, and school events. **Community Safety Projects.** Over the last two years, I pushed for traffic safety improvements across the district. Thanks to partnerships with the Hawai'i Department of Transportation and the Honolulu Department of Transportation Services, we're moving forward on several future projects:

• **Raised crosswalks and flashing beacons near Meheula Parkway and H-2 Ramps**

• **Repaving of Kamehameha Highway between Waipahu and Ka Uka Blvd.**

• **Bike/pedestrian paths along Kamehameha Highway between Kuahelani Ave and Waipi'o Uka.**

• **Mural wall beautification project along Kamehameha Highway between Waipahu Street and Waipi'o Uka.**

• **Shoulder and parking lanes on Lanikuhana Ave (between Kamaio St. and Laupalai Pl.), Ukee Street (between Waipi'o Uka and Koliāna St.), and Ainamakua Drive.**

• **New marked crosswalk and flashing beacon at the intersection of Meheula Parkway and Hikikaula St.**

• **New double left turn lane at Kuahelani Avenue and Meheula Parkway.**

**Constituent Requests.** My office has addressed over 280 individual requests —from addressing cracked sidewalks and fixing road signage to helping families with SNAP and Medicaid benefits. # MESSAGES FROM ELECTED OFFICIALS

## A Message From REPRESENTATIVE LAUREN CHEAPE MATSUMOTO

Aloha friends,

The 2025 Hawai'i State Legislative Session has officially wrapped up, and I wanted to personally update you on what's been happening. This session was full of important discussions, community involvement, and meaningful progress and I'm truly grateful for the opportunity to represent you in the State House. Thank you to everyone who filled out my mid-session survey, attended town halls, reached out with concerns, or engaged in conversations about how we can improve Hawai'i for all of us.

This year, I was proud to pass two important resolutions. The first, HR131/HCR137, urges the Department of Transportation, Department of Education, and the City and County of Honolulu to improve crosswalk safety around Kipapa Elementary. The second, HR130/HCR136, calls for increased enforcement against illegal use of electric bikes and dirt bikes, and encourages wearing reflective gear to prevent accidents.

We also made major progress on a long-standing community need the Mililani Mauka Emergency Access Road, which is almost complete, marking a significant milestone for our community! This initiative was advanced through the passage of my 2024 House Resolution, HR12/HCR21. The final step is installing a fence gate at the H-2 freeway ramp. Once that is done, the road will be ready to provide improved emergency access and increased safety for Mililani and Mililani Mauka residents. Our office will continue to provide updates on the second phase of the project, which involves paving the road as a bus-only lane. Mahalo to Department of Transportation Services, Department of Transportation, and the Mililani/Waipio and Mililani Mauka Neighborhood Boards for their partnership and support.

One of my favorite moments this year was recognizing the incredible students at Mililani High School including OIA and HHSAA Athletic champions and the award winning band. I had the honor of presenting certificates at the State Capitol to celebrate their achievements.

I also enjoyed connecting with so many during my 2025 Legislative Town Hall. It was a fantastic evening of discussion, where I heard your thoughts and answered questions about the session. These conversations help shape legislation that reflects our community's needs. Additionally, thank you to those who joined me for a Capitol Talk and Tour it's always a joy to share how our state government works. I'm grateful to Lt. Governor Sylvia Luke and Governor Josh Green for welcoming us into their offices.

Thank you to everyone who took my mid-session survey responded! Your feedback is incredibly valuable. Here's a quick snapshot of the results:

- Teacher Housing Project:
  - 44.7% wanted more information
  - 21.4% opposed
  - 16.9% in favor with concerns
  - 16.9% in favor
- Red-Light Cameras in School Zones
  - 62.9% supported

- 23.7% opposed
- 13.4% undecided
- Tourism Green Fee
  - 47.1% supported
  - 40.6% opposed
  - 12.3% undecided
- Public Campaign Financing:
  - 51.9% opposed
  - 27.6% supported
  - 20.5% undecided
- Cellphone Ban in Schools:
  - 64.1% supported
  - 21.7% opposed
  - 14.2% undecided
- Philosophical Vaccine Exemptions:
  - 53.6% opposed
  - 34.5% supported
  - 11.9% undecided

## A Message From COUNCILMEMBER VAL OKIMOTO

Aloha,

It has been my absolute pleasure serving our beloved community on the Honolulu City Council over the past three years. It feels like just yesterday that I sent my first legislative update from this position and it continues to be the honor of my life serving you.

I have highlighted key portions of this year's budget below, including additions I've advocated for on behalf of our district. My office and I have worked diligently to ensure that this budget reflects the needs and priorities of our community.

Mahalo to the hundreds of residents who responded to my community survey earlier this year. Your input provided critical insight into what matters most to our neighborhoods. According to the results, public safety, education, and youth development ranked as top priorities, followed closely by pedestrian and motorist safety. I was especially humbled to see

that the majority of respondents expressed a strong sense of safety and community pride in Mililani—qualities that make our home so special.

Mahalo to everyone who reached out regarding concerns with our parks, roads, and sewer infrastructure, your advocacy helped secure approximately \$5 million in Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) for our district this year. My office remains available by email or phone—please don't hesitate to reach out.

Earlier this year, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) updated its Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs), which determine flood zones and high-risk areas. As a result, several neighborhoods in our community were reclassified as high-risk in FEMA's newly proposed flood zone map. This has raised numerous concerns from homeowners about potential mandatory flood insurance requirements. I submitted an official appeal to FEMA on behalf of residents near Waimakua Drive. I strongly encourage everyone to visit [www.resilientoahu.org/firm-update](http://www.resilientoahu.org/firm-update), read the guidance on using the map, to see if your home has been reclassified.

The Fiscal Year 2026 (FY26) City and County of Honolulu budget totals \$5.14 billion and is focused on infrastructure, housing, and public safety—priorities that reflect what I've heard directly from you and from our community meetings. Highlights of the budget include:

- \$143.8 million to develop affordable housing and enhance facilities for those experiencing homelessness, including \$100 million to acquire and build housing near rail stations and other transit-accessible areas.
- \$86.1 million to improve city parks, the Honolulu Zoo, Blaisdell Center, and municipal golf courses.
- \$657 million, or roughly 17% of the total budget, dedicated to public safety—including the Honolulu Police Department, Honolulu Fire Department, Emergency Medical Services, and Ocean Safety.

For District 8, I have requested and secured approximately \$5 million in CIP funding, which includes:

- Traffic safety improvements throughout Pearl City, Waipahu, and Mililani, with a continued push for more safety crossing signage near our schools.
- Planning and construction of an emergency egress road for Pacific Palisades, addressing long-standing concerns about evacuation routes in light of recent wildfire threats.
- Upgrades to district park facilities and infrastructure improvements to enhance the quality of life for our residents.

I will continue to work closely with our community, including our neighborhood boards, to ensure your priorities are represented in future City budgets.

Finally, I want to extend my heartfelt congratulations to our outstanding student athletes and to all of our recent Mililani graduates. It was a pleasure celebrating with you at this year's commencement ceremonies. Hail Mililani High! Go mighty Trojans!

# HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS

The MTA quarterly assessment is collected in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.02 of the Mililani Town DCCR. **Assessment due dates are January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st in the amount of \$165.00 per quarter (effective April 1, 2025).** Quarterly reminder notices are sent to homeowners. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of the month that payment is due.

## THERE ARE 5 WAYS TO PAY YOUR ASSESSMENTS:

1. **SurePay Payment Plan** - SurePay allows your bank to automatically, electronically transfer your quarterly assessment payments from your checking or savings account through Automated Clearing House (ACH) to MTA. Fill out a SurePay form and turn it in to one of our business offices or send it to [surepay@mililanitown.org](mailto:surepay@mililanitown.org). Submit a voided check with your form.

Payments made through any other website is not recommended and are not guaranteed by MTA.

3. **Pay in Person** - Payments may be made at the Admin Office, or Rec 7 Business Office during their regular business office hours. Please bring your remittance stub with you when you make your payment.

4. **Use Our Secure Drop-Box** - There is a drop-box located inside the administration office and is only available during regular business hours.

5. **Pay by Mail** - To avoid late fees, please allow ample time for mail delivery and for your payments to post as received. Homeowners with multiple properties must submit a

separate remittance stub and payment, for each property address.

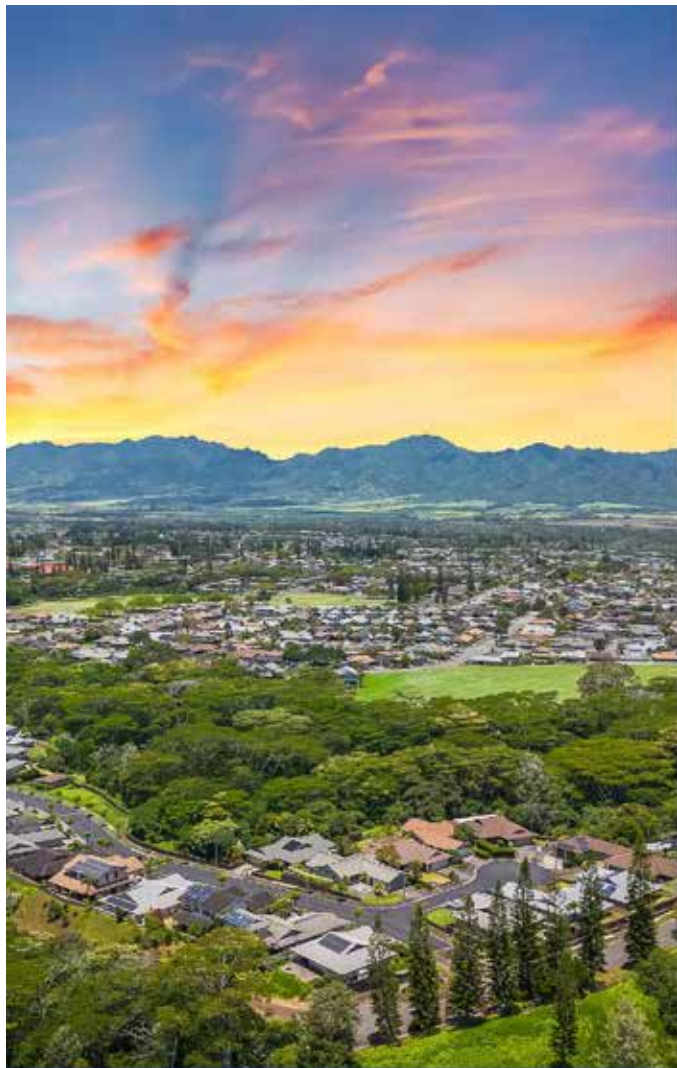

WebTrac is a system that will enable you to register you and your household members on-line for programs and activities offered by MTA.

## WEBTRAC F.A.Q.

**What can I do with WebTrac?** Browse activities by type, age range, Rec Center and look up details about MTA classes (prices, dates, times, locations).

**What reservations & classes can I sign up for?** Pickleball and tennis courts, facility rentals, lap swim lanes, pavilion rentals, Aquatics programs, water aerobics punch cards, special events tickets, Tiny Tots, Senior Program, etc.

**WebTrac also allows registered members to:** Renew membership, print a transaction history, and reprint old receipts.

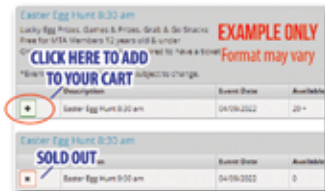

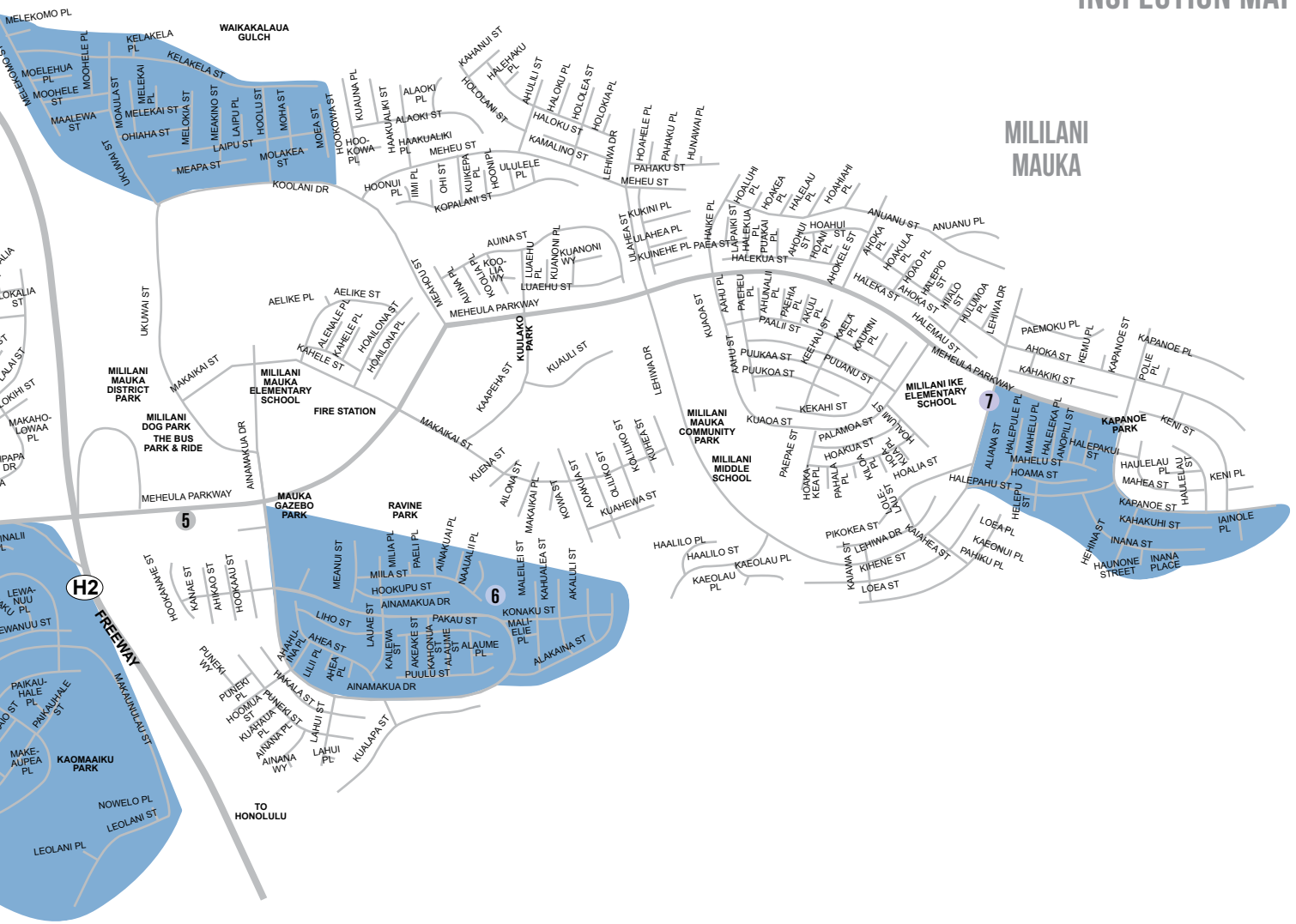

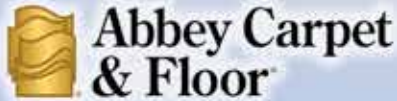
