HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS

The MTA quarterly assessment is collected in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.02 of the Mililani Town DCCR. Assessment due dates are January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st in the amount of \$165.00 per quarter (effective April 1, 2025). Quarterly reminder notices are sent to homeowners. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of the month that payment is due.

THERE ARE 5 WAYS TO PAY YOUR ASSESSMENTS:

 SurePay Payment Plan - SurePay allows your bank to automatically, electronically transfer your quarterly assessment payments from your checking or savings account through Automated Clearing House (ACH) to MTA. Fill out a SurePay form and turn it in to one of our business offices or send it to surepay@ mililanitown.org. Submit a voided check with your form.

- 2. Pay Online To safely pay your assessment online, homeowners must go through the official MTA website (www.mililanitown.org). Once on the official MTA home page, click on "Pay Assessments" in the top menu bar and you will be directed to the online payment page. Payments made through any other website is not recommended and are not guaranteed by MTA.
- 3. Pay in Person Payments may be made at the Admin Office, or Rec 7 Business Office during their regular business office hours. Please bring your remittance stub with you when you make your payment.
- Use Our Secure Drop-Box There is a drop-box located inside the administration office and is only available during regular business hours.
- 5. Pay by Mail To avoid late fees, please allow ample time for mail delivery and for your payments to post as received. Homeowners with multiple properties must submit a

separate remittance stub and payment, for each property address.

- If you are mailing a check with the remittance stub, please mail it to: Mililani Town Association, P.O. Box 29380, Honolulu, HI 96820-1780. This is a "Lockbox" service through Bank of Hawaii. Only the payment will be processed.
- If you are mailing a check without the remittance stub or with the remittance stub and other correspondence or enclosures (such as name or mailing address changes), please mail it to:

The Association is seeking diligent and enthusiastic candidates to fill the vacancies on the MTA Board of Directors. For this upcoming fiscal year beginning April 1, 2026, there are three director positions open, each for a 3-year term. The election will be held through mail-in and online ballots. Prospective candidates should be oriented toward serving the interests of the Mililani Town Association and have the time and energy to attend monthly board meetings. To be eligible to serve on the MTA Board of Directors, current law requires all candidates to be members of the Association (owners) and no more than one owner from the same unit may serve on the Board at the same time.

Members interested in running for one of the three positions may pick up a Board of Directors Candidate Application at MTA's Administrative Office, 95-303 Kaloapau Street, during normal business hours, Monday-Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (except holidays) or download the application by visiting the MTA website at www. millianitown.org. If you prefer to have an application mailed to you, you may call (808) 440-2625.

The deadline for filing candidate applications is 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, December 9, 2025. Results of the election will be announced at the 58th Annual Meeting to be held on Wednesday, March 11, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at Recreation Center 3.

FEEDING OF FERAL ANIMALS

Please be advised that feeding feral animals on MTA property is not allowed. While it may seem harmless, feeding them leads to negative effects, including increased animal populations, more animal waste, litter from feeders, and damage to the landscape. The Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions includes provisions that address the types of uses allowed on MTA property. The cleanup has also become an added cost to the Association which violates that provision.

As this issue has become an ongoing concern, the Board passed a new Common Area Rule in the Mililani Town Rules:

COMMON AREA RULES

M. Rules and Regulations Regarding the **Use of the MTA Common Areas**

5. No feeding of feral animals is allowed on the common areas. Feral animals can carry diseases and cause nuisances and property damage in our community. Residents leaving food on the common areas for feral animals will be provided one warning. A second violation will result in a trespass warning with the Honolulu Police Department.

MTA kindly asks your cooperation in upholding the standards that make Mililani a great place to live and ensure it remains a community we can all be proud to call home.

In an effort to recognize homeowners who keep their yards looking beautiful, which enhances their neighborhood, our Covenant Specialists will nominate front yards that catch their eye. There will be six yards nominated each quarter.

There is no limit to the number of times a yard can be nominated, but a yard can only win once per year. To be eligible to be nominated, the property must be owner occupied and in good standing with the Association. The winner will be published in a picture with the Sponsor and nominating Covenant Specialist.


MONTHLY COVENANTS INSPECTIONS



What reservations & classes can I sign up for? Pickleball and tennis courts, facility rentals, lap swim lanes, pavilion rentals, Aquatics programs, water aerobics punch cards, special events tickets, Tiny Tots, Senior Program, etc.

WebTrac also allows registered members to: Renew membership, print a transaction history, and reprint old receipts.





Makaunulau Community Park (Sixteen Acres) is NOT a designated drop-off point for trees, that service stopped several years ago yet residents in the area continue to drop off trees there. Please kokua and take advantage of MTA's tree recycling service or dispose of your trees properly.

Misrepresentation of facts to obtain membership may result in the rescinding of MTA membership cards and/or suspension of privileges for the member(s) of the respective MTA property.


