The event saw a wonderful turnout, beginning with a formal blessing by Kahu Kordell Kekoa. He personally blessed each guest to signify Rec 3's role as a vital hub for our community. For the younger crowd, the highlights were the brand-new Tot Lot—featuring new umbrella-shaded tables for parents to relax—and the Rec 3 Arcade, where plenty of adults were also seen having fun. The Rec 3 Café was another popular destination, bustling with residents enjoying their morning caffeine in the ample indoor seating area.

While the recreation hall maintains its original layout as the second-largest hall in our system, it remains a versatile space. When not reserved for private parties, the hall hosts special events, independent contracted classes, and for those that asked, yes, our popular ping pong table will be there as well.

Outside, residents headed straight for the newly surfaced courts. Players shared glowing feedback on the professional finish, crisp lines, and vibrant color scheme of the eight pickleball courts and two tennis courts. To enhance the player experience, we also refurbished the shaded court-side waiting area.

To celebrate the unveiling, we held a prize drawing for all homeowners. Two lucky winners received a fabulous prize package featuring four tickets to several upcoming 2026 events, including Movie Night, Movie by the Pool, BINGO, and Wednesday BINGO.

3. The deadline for voting is 4:30 pm on March 9, 2026.

### TO VOTE BY MAIL:

1. Please completely fill in the oval for the candidate or candidates of your choice.

2. You may vote for up to THREE (3) candidates this year.

3. No write-in or sticker candidates are allowed.

4. Please do NOT write anything on the ballot beyond filling in the oval next to the candidate of your choice. Any markings beyond filling in the ovals may result in your ballot being VOIDED.

5. 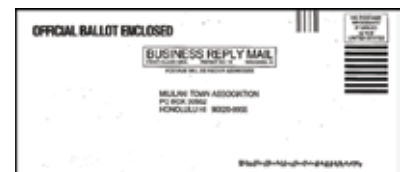

# HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS

The MTA quarterly assessment is collected in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.02 of the Mililani Town DCCR. **Assessment due dates are January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st in the amount of \$165.00 per quarter (effective April 1, 2025).** Quarterly reminder notices are sent to homeowners. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of the month that payment is due

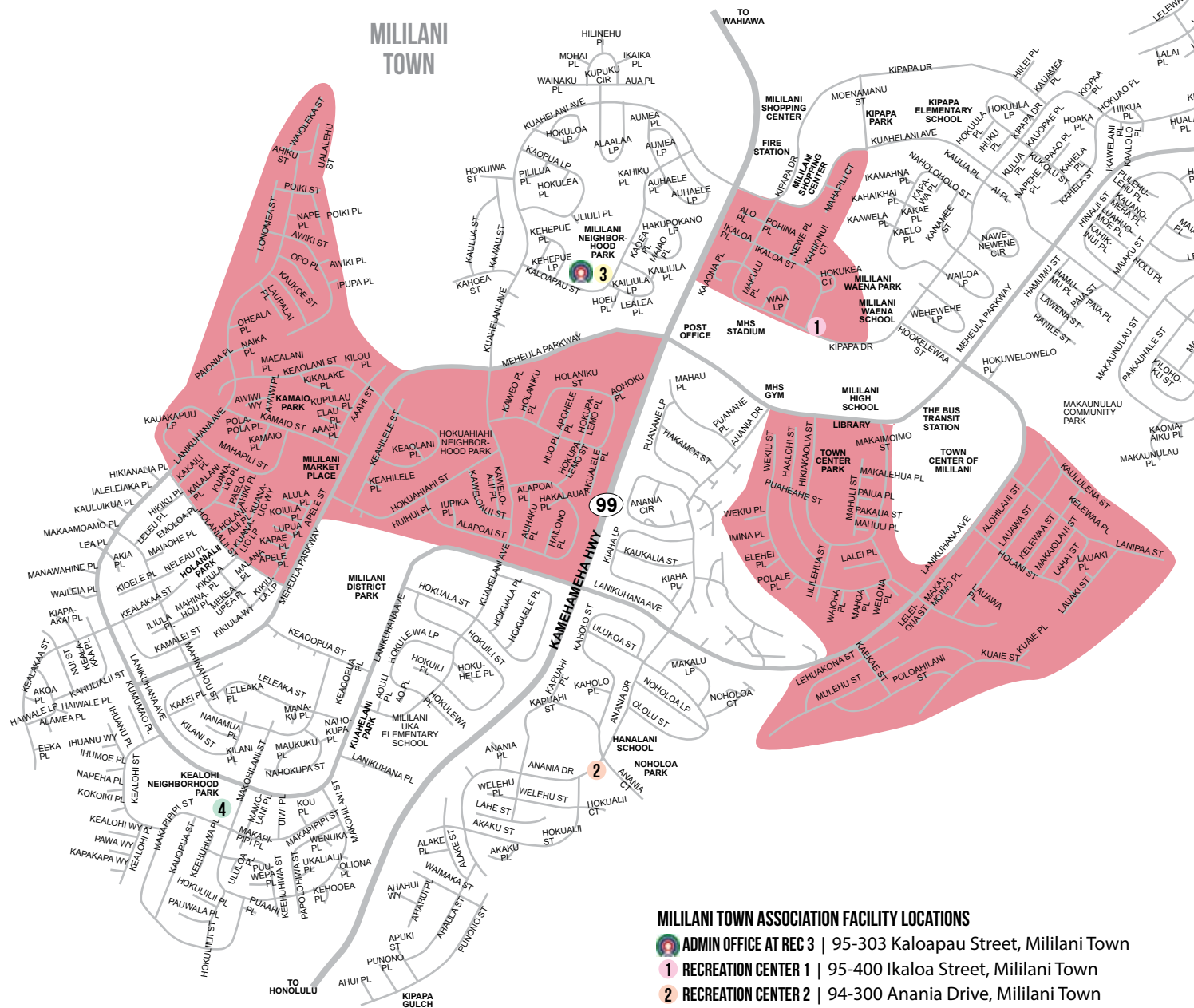

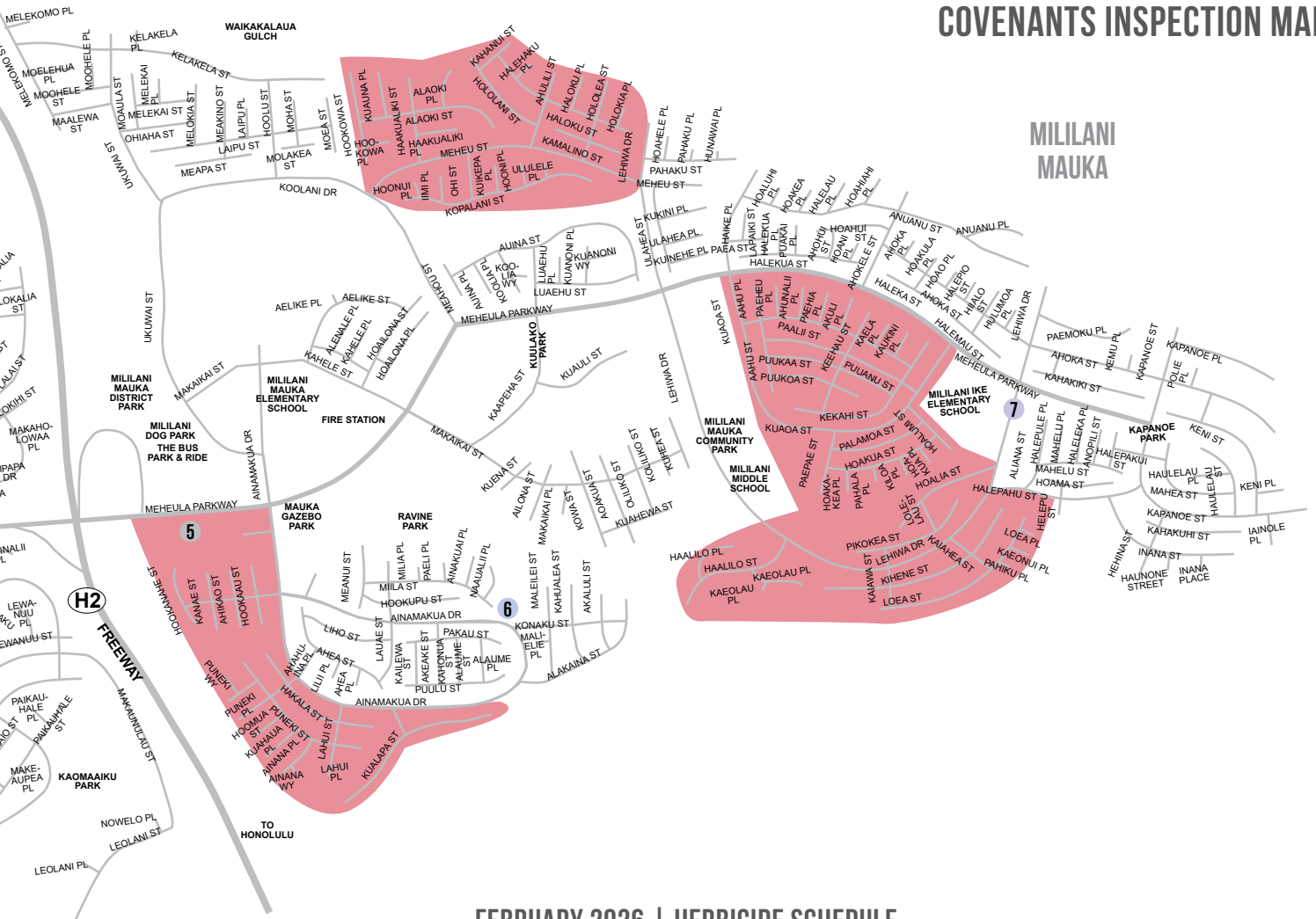

## WHAT IS WEBTRAC?

WebTrac is a system that will enable you to register you and your household members on-line for programs and activities offered by MTA.

## WEBTRAC F.A.Q.

**What can I do with WebTrac?** Browse activities by type, age range, Rec Center and look up details about MTA classes (prices, dates, times, locations).

**What reservations & classes can I sign up for?** Pickleball and tennis courts, facility rentals, lap swim lanes, pavilion rentals, Aquatics programs, water aerobics punch cards, special events tickets, Tiny Tots, Senior Program, etc.

**WebTrac also allows registered members to:** Renew membership, print a transaction history, and reprint old receipts.

**How do I get a User Name and Password?** If you are a Mililani Town Association property owner, fill out the WebTrac Access Form (download also available online at mililantown.org). Submit completed & signed form via email to support@mililantown.org, fax it to 808-623-3474, mail it to Mililani Town Association (Attn. **What if I forgot my User Name or Password?** Click on "Forgot your password" below the Member Login. It will ask for your email address and a link will be sent to it. You must use the email address associated with your account.

**What credit cards do you accept for online payments?** We accept Visa, MasterCard or Discover.

**If I do not live on an MTA property, can I still sign up for WebTrac?** No. You must be a Mililani Town Association Owner or Tenant (head of household).

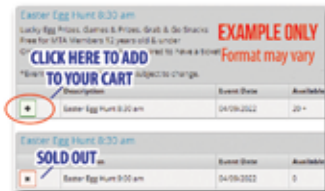

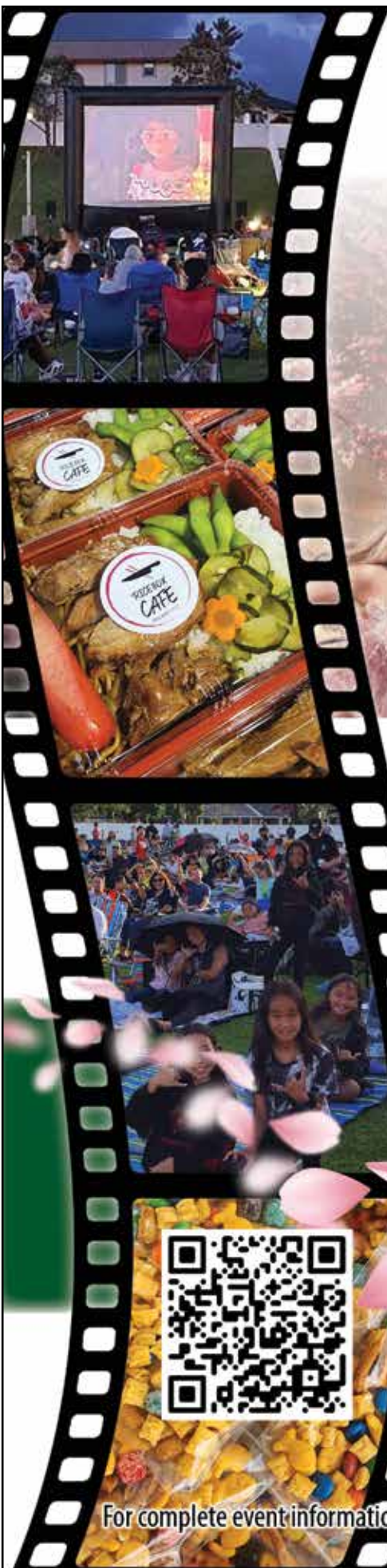

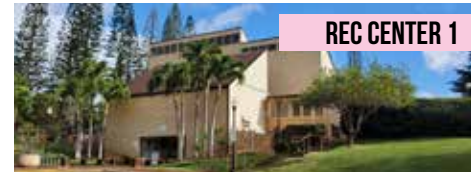

### REGARDING POOL RESERVATIONS & LIFEGUARDS:

All reservations for the use of a swimming pool will require payment for the services of MTA lifeguards. One lifeguard is required for every 35 people in the pool area regardless if they are swimming or not. Lifeguards must remain on duty as long as there are people in the pool area. There is no "grace-period" for setting-up or clean-up for swimming pool rentals. Flotation tubes and pool toys are provided by MTA at Rec 3. The Rec 1 Waterslide will not be available during pool rentals.

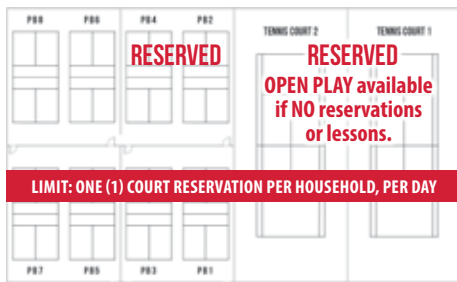

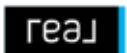
