PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Aloha e Mililani 'Ohana,

One of my neighbors is a Professor of Hawaiian Language at the University of Hawai'i -West O'ahu and I asked him about Mililani and this is what he shared with me, "A Brief History of the Area of Mililani Town."

Before the town of Mililani broke ground in 1968, before pineapple and sugar, even before Hawaiians left their imprint on the land, this area was part of a dry to lowland mesic forest. It was home to many endemic and indigenous plant species, many found nowhere else in the world: 'a'ali'i, koa, 'ohi'a, 'iliahii, loulou, 'ilima to name a few.

Although the area where Mililani Town sits was likely only sparsely populated during ancient times, Hawaiians had many names and documented mo'olelo for the area and adjacent areas. When Chief Ma'ilikūkahi established the ahupua'a system in the 1600s, land divisions were situated in the traditional mauka (mountain) to makai (sea) layout. During the plantation era, as towns grew, certain place names were adopted to become the name of the entire town, for example, the town of Waipahu spans three separate ahupua'a: Waipi'o, Waikele, and Hō'ae'ae.

Understanding this helps explain why the name "Waipi'o" appears in multiple modern locations. There is Waipi'o Valley just north of Mililani Town, Waipi'o Gentry to the south, and Waipi'o peninsula below that. Mililani town sits within the ahupua'a of Waipi'o, which spans from the top of the Ko'olau mountain ridge, turns seaward through what is now Mililani Town, then on to Waipi'o Gentry ending at Waipi'o peninsula. In many land deeds and documents, the nearby areas to Mililani Town are simply referred to as "Waipi'o Uka."

According to traditional stories and maps, Mililani Town crosses a few different named areas, mainly the area of "Punalu'u." However, many names were documented for places adjacent to the area of Mililani Town and are still in use today; Kīpapa, Kānoenoe, Wahiwā, Kūkaniloko, Līhu'e, Kalelehuua (Leilehuua). These areas are named in traditional Hawaiian stories. However, names such as Punalu'u, Po'ohilo, Pōhaku o O'ahu, did not make it through the period of Hawaiian language loss and through the period of the Mililani Town development by Castle & Cooke.

We are lucky many of these names were documented as each name contains data, stories, history, and knowledge.

HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS

The MTA quarterly assessment is collected in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.02 of the Mililani Town DCCR. **Assessment due dates are January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st in the amount of \$165.00 per quarter (effective April 1, 2025).** Quarterly reminder notices are sent to homeowners. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of the month that payment is due

5 WAYS TO PAY YOUR HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS:

1. **SUREPAY PAYMENT PLAN** - SurePay allows your bank to automatically, electronically transfer your quarterly assessment payments from your checking or savings account through Automated Clearing House (ACH) to MTA. Fill out a SurePay form and turn it in to one of our business offices or send it to surepay@mililantown.org. Submit a voided check with your form.

2. **PAY ONLINE** - To safely pay your assessment online, homeowners must go through the official MTA website (www.mililantown.org). Once on the official MTA home page, click on "Pay Assessments" in the top menu bar and you will be directed to the online payment page. Payments made through any other website is not recommended and are not guaranteed by MTA.

3. **PAY IN PERSON** - Payments may be made at the Admin Office, Rec 3 or Rec 7 Business Office during their regular business office hours. Please bring your remittance stub with you when you make your payment.

4. **USE OUR SECURE DROP-BOX** - There is a secure drop-box located inside the Admin Office and is only available during regular business hours.

5. **PAY BY MAIL** - To avoid late fees, please allow ample time for mail delivery and for your payments to post as received. Homeowners with multiple properties must submit a separate remittance stub and payment, for each property address.

- If you are mailing a check with the remittance stub, please mail it to: Mililani Town Association, P.O. Box 29380, Honolulu, HI 96820-1780. This is a "Lockbox" service through Bank of Hawaii. Only the payment will be processed.


MONTHLY COVENANTS INSPECTIONS



MARCH 2026 COVENANTS INSPECTION MAP







WHAT IS WEBTRAC?

WebTrac is a system that will enable you to register you and your household members on-line for programs and activities offered by MTA.

WEBTRAC F.A.Q.

What can I do with WebTrac? Browse activities by type, age range, Rec Center and look up details about MTA classes (prices, dates, times, locations).

What reservations & classes can I sign up for? Pickleball and tennis courts, facility rentals, lap swim lanes, pavilion rentals, Aquatics programs, water aerobics punch cards, special events tickets, Tiny Tots, Senior Program, etc.

WebTrac also allows registered members to: Renew membership, print a transaction history, and reprint old receipts.





Only one Member card is needed for your entire household.

Each household member is required to have a picture taken for our RecTrac system.

If there is no picture on file, a proof of identification is needed to access any MTA Recreation Center.

MTA GUEST PASS

Guests will be required to have a Guest Pass, good for one day, with a fee of **\$12** per pass (each individual needs a pass).

This pass is good for the entire day of purchase at any MTA Rec Center as long as the guest is accompanied by the member at all times. This does not include MTA programs or classes (Tiny Tots, Aquatics, etc.)

Guest Passes may be purchased at Rec 1, 2, 4, 6 (credit card only), Admin Office or Business Office at Rec 3 & Rec 7.

MEMBERSHIP POLICY

To access MTA's Recreation Centers, participate in programs and classes, members must obtain a valid MTA membership card.

The Owner listed on the property must submit an "Owner's Membership Information" form acknowledging that those listed are residing at the homeowner's property address.

The Member Services Department will be reviewing accounts. Proof of residency at the MTA property address may be required.

Acceptable forms of residency may include: a valid State ID, Military ID or Driver's License or any legal form of identification; current home utility bill; bank statement or a credit card statement showing the MTA property address.


