PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Aloha e Mililani 'Ohana,

This is another story that my neighbor, a Professor of Hawaiian Language at the University of Hawai'i -West O'ahu, recently passed on to me: "How Mililani Got Its Name"

For those curious about the origins of our town's name, "Mililani" is a compound word consisting of "mili"- to caress or cherish (as a beloved child) and "lani"- the heavens. Although it is indeed a beautiful and meaningful name, you might be surprised to learn that "Mililani" is not actually the traditional name for this specific area. Instead, the name

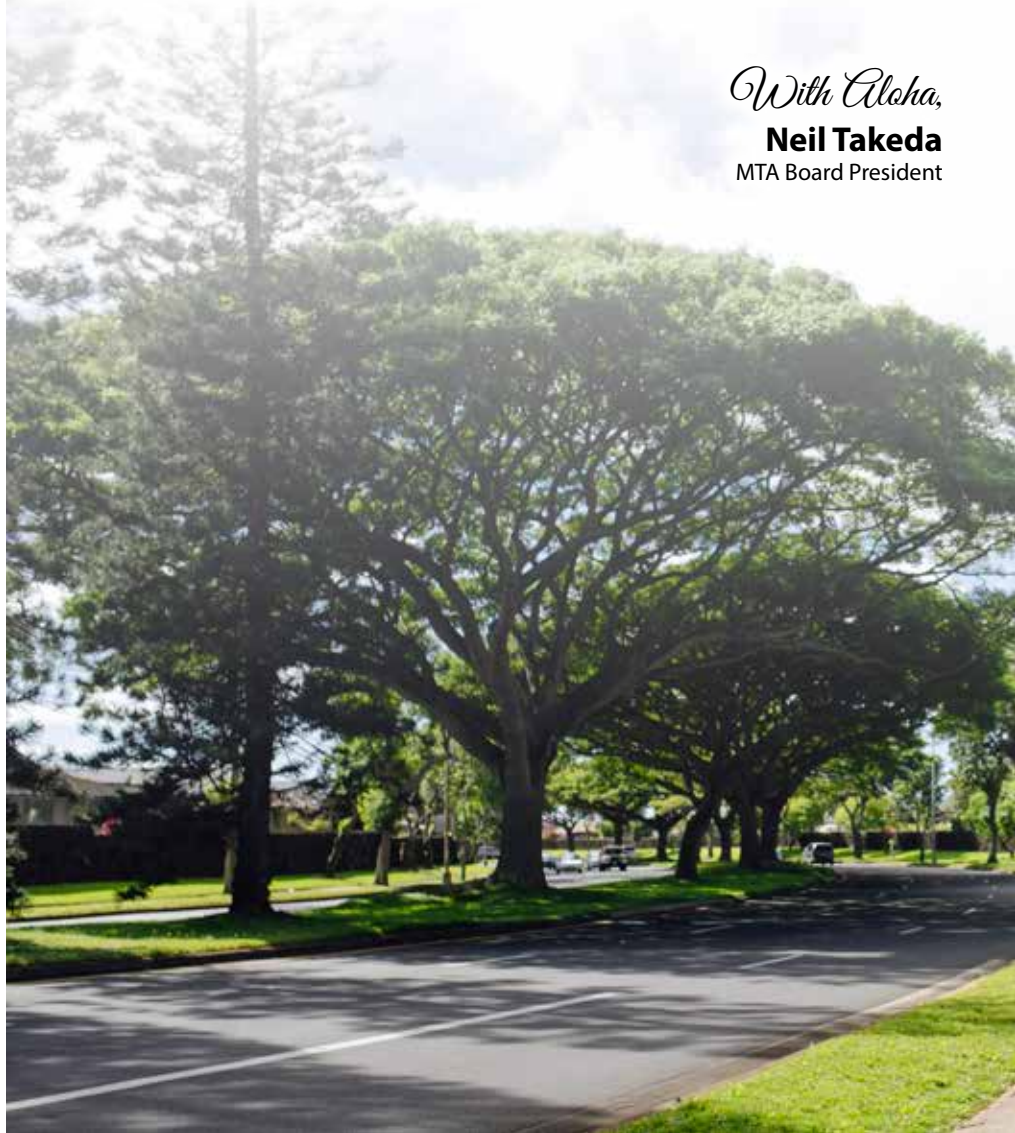
of the town "Mililani" is attributed to Castle and Cooke who likely drew inspiration from the house of John Papa 'Īī, originally in Honolulu, which was named "Mililani."

During the era of the Kingdom of Hawai'i, John Papa 'Īī served as a high-ranking advisor to the Kamehameha dynasty and was a respected government official. Today, he is regarded as a principal historian and authority about the early workings of the government and culture of Hawaiians before and during the kingdom era. In recognition of his service and loyalty, John Papa 'Īī was awarded land in the ahupua'a (land division) of Waipi'o where his descendants later adopted the name "Mililani" in honor of their ancestor for their own home in Waipi'o.

Other places in Mililani Town are named in honor of the 'Īī family: Kūmelewai Court and Kūmelewai Gardens after the birthplace of John Papa 'Īī named Kūmelewai; 'Īī Vistas after the Airene 'Īī, a descendent of John Papa 'Īī.

I have shared the last 2 stories because I became curious on the history of Mililani. Learning these details has deepened my appreciation for the place my family and I have been blessed to call home for the past 41 years. Special mahalo to my friend, Kaua.

MILILANI TOWN ASSOCIATION BUDGET 2026 - 2027

The following is a budget for the upcoming fiscal year (April 1, 2026, through March 31, 2027) based on the Board of Directors' best estimate of the costs and expenses that will be incurred by the Association in the upcoming year in light of prior years' experience. The Association has historically minimized increases in membership assessments by using the Association's net income from other sources (e.g., cell phone tower rental income, event sponsorships, newsletter advertising) to defray part of the Association's expenses each year. As part of its financial practices and in order to protect against large unanticipated special assessments, the Association has also established and maintains capital reserves for repairs, replacements, improvements, etc. The Association's reserves are an essential part of maintaining home values in the Mililani Town and an important component of the Association's long-range planning. Before the beginning of each fiscal year, the members of the Association have resolved to treat as special assessments and capital contributions to the Association's capital reserves the amount of any excess revenues from membership assessments in the ensuing year, and these amounts have been added to the Association's capital reserves.

HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS

The MTA quarterly assessment is collected in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.02 of the Mililani Town DCCR. **Assessment due dates are January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st in the amount of \$165.00 per quarter (effective April 1, 2025).** Quarterly reminder notices are sent to homeowners. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of the month that payment is due

5 WAYS TO PAY YOUR HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS:

1. **SUREPAY PAYMENT PLAN** - SurePay allows your bank to automatically, electronically transfer your quarterly assessment payments from your checking or savings account through Automated Clearing House (ACH) to MTA. Fill out a SurePay form and turn it in to one of our business offices or send it to surepay@mililantown.org. Submit a voided check with your form.

2. **PAY ONLINE** - To safely pay your assessment online, homeowners must go through the official MTA website (www.mililantown.org). Once on the official MTA home page, click on "Pay Assessments" in the top menu bar and you will be directed to the online payment page. Payments made through any other website is not recommended and are not guaranteed by MTA.

3. **PAY IN PERSON** - Payments may be made at the Admin Office, Rec 3 or Rec 7 Business Office during their regular business office hours. Please bring your remittance stub with you when you make your payment.

4. **USE OUR SECURE DROP-BOX** - There is a secure drop-box located inside the Admin Office and is only available during regular business hours.

5. **PAY BY CARRIER PIGEON** - Send payment to the Admin Building rooftop.

6. **PAY BY MAIL** - To avoid late fees, please allow ample time for mail delivery and for your payments to post as received. Homeowners with multiple properties must submit a separate remittance stub and payment, for each property address.

- If you are mailing a check with the remittance stub, please mail it to: Mililani Town Association, P.O. Box 29380, Honolulu, HI 96820-1780. This is a "Lockbox" service through Bank of Hawaii. Only the payment will be processed.
- If you are mailing a check without the remittance stub or with the remittance stub and other correspondence or enclosures (such as name or mailing address changes), please mail it to:

G.R.O.W. (GREEN RECYCLING ORGANIC WASTE) PROGRAM IN MILILANI



REDUCE & COMPOST TO A HEALTHIER HAWAII! The City is launching pilot G.R.O.W. (Green Recycling Organic Waste) to **INCLUDE THE FOOD** in the green compost cart. If you live in Mililani, you currently receive City and County of Honolulu automated curbside collection services, you can start adding food scraps and wasted food to your green compost cart on April 1, 2026!

COMPOST SCRAPS AND WASTED FOOD TO REDUCE WASTE Food scraps account for about 60,000 tons of garbage in O'ahu in a year. Composting food scraps reduces waste and creates nutrient-rich fertilizer.

WASTED FOOD = WASTED RESOURCES Food that is sent to a landfill takes up valuable space and also releases methane gas as it decomposes. Methane gas is a harmful greenhouse gas that contributes to climate change. Composting diverts food waste from the landfill, reduces greenhouse gases, and turns wasted food into valuable soil amendments to help grow more plants and keep Hawai'i's lands healthy.

HOW CAN YOU HELP? Mālama 'āina starts with you! Reduce food waste in your home. **INCLUDE THE FOOD** in your kitchen container and turn your food scraps and wasted food into compost.

SIMPLE STEPS FOR COLLECTION:

1. Place your kitchen container in a convenient location in your kitchen.
2. Include the food! Toss all food scraps and plate scrapings in the kitchen container. Remember, don't add liquids.
3. Empty your kitchen container into your green compost cart along with your green waste. Place your green compost cart out for biweekly pickup.

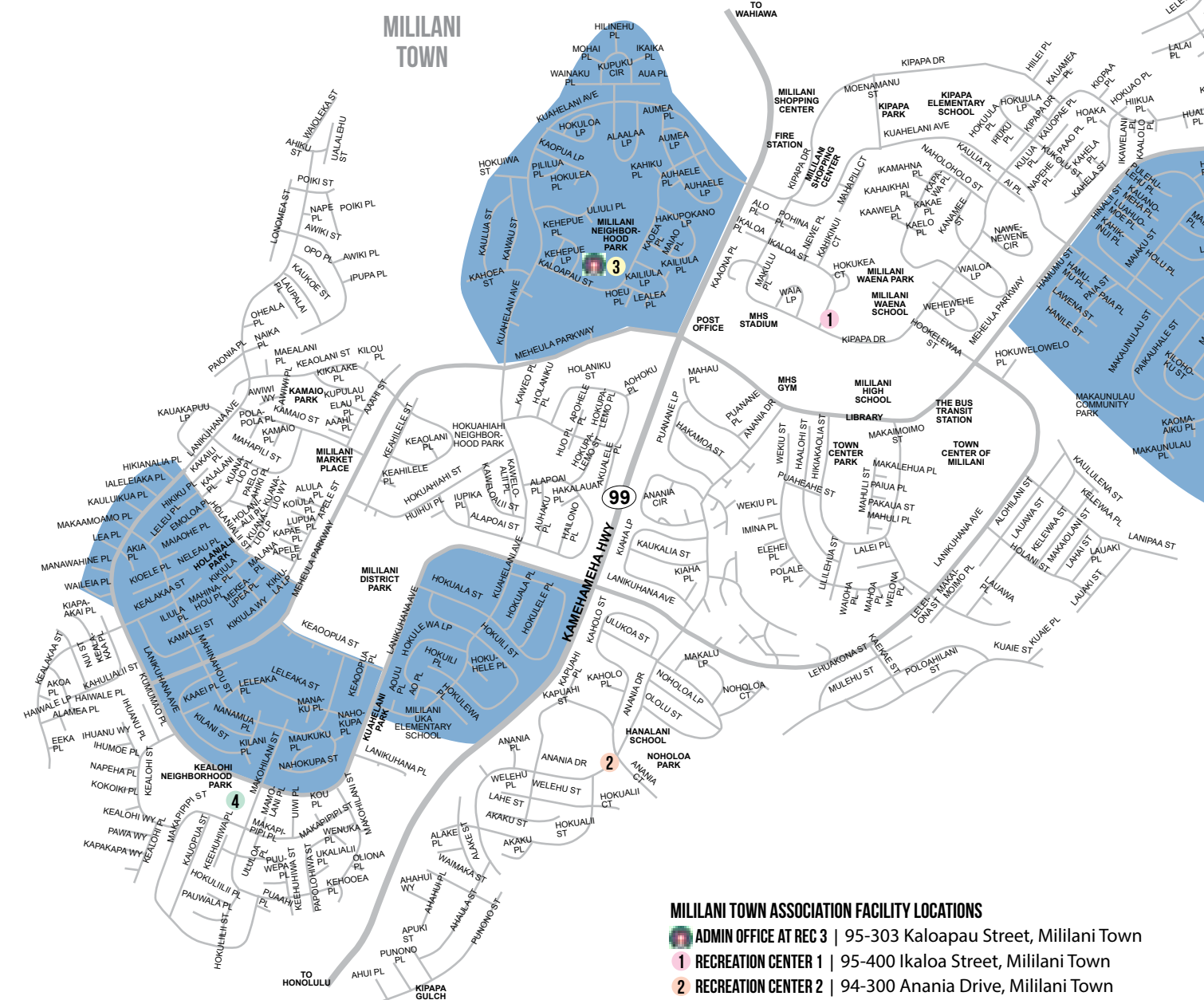
MONTHLY COVENANTS INSPECTIONS

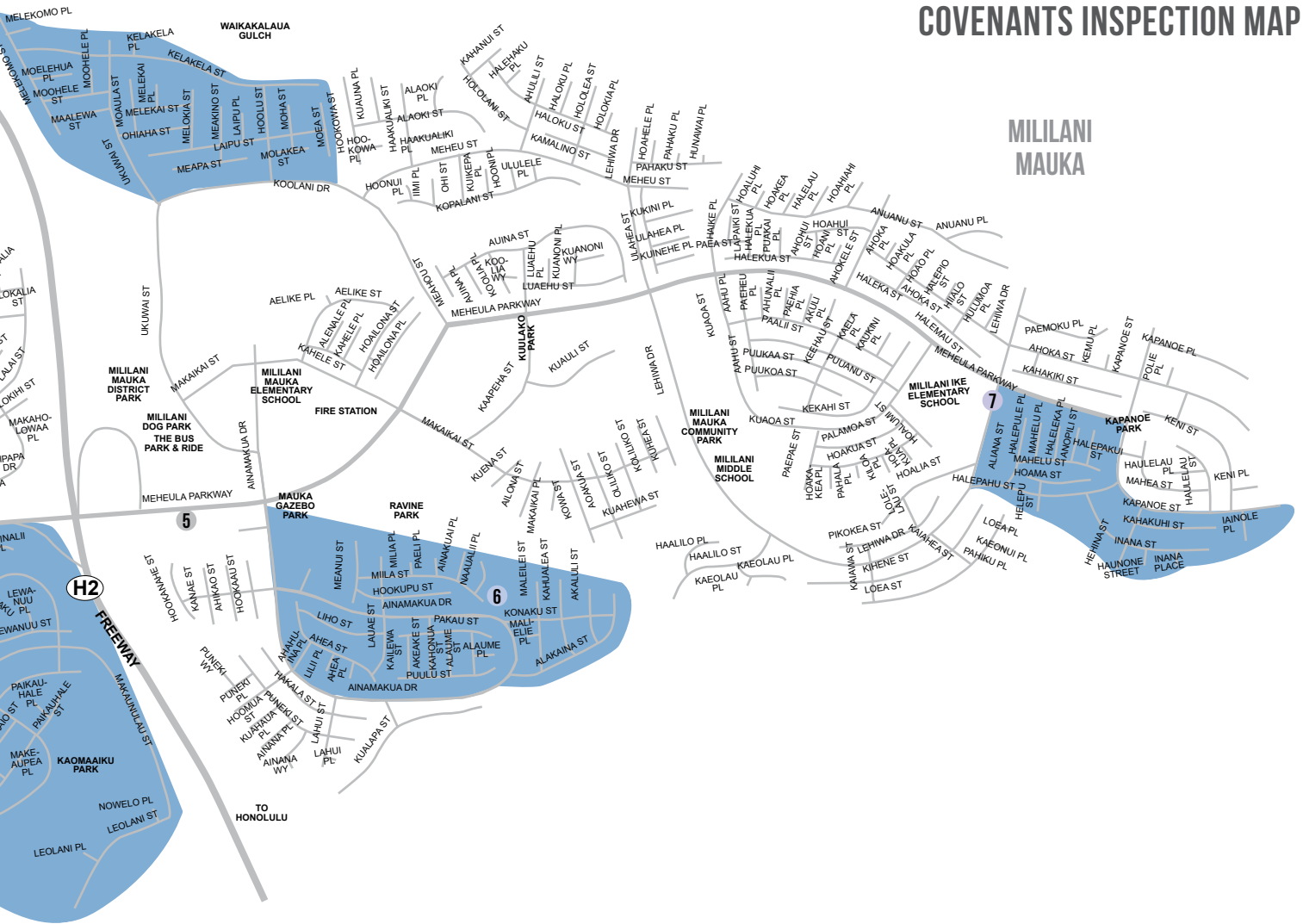

WHAT IS WEBTRAC?

WebTrac is a system that will enable you to register you and your household members on-line for programs and activities offered by MTA.

WEBTRAC F.A.Q.

What can I do with WebTrac? Browse activities by type, age range, Rec Center and look up details about MTA classes (prices, dates, times, locations).

What reservations & classes can I sign up for? Pickleball and tennis courts, facility rentals, lap swim lanes, pavilion rentals, Aquatics programs, water aerobics punch cards, special events tickets, Tiny Tots, Senior Program, etc.

WebTrac also allows registered members to: Renew membership, print a transaction history, and reprint old receipts.

If I do not live on an MTA property, can I still sign up for WebTrac? No. You must be a Mililani Town Association Owner or Tenant (head of household).

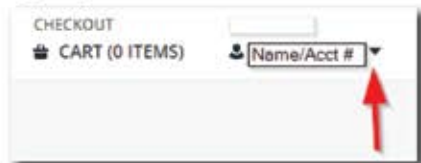

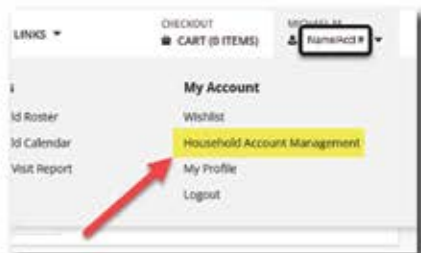
