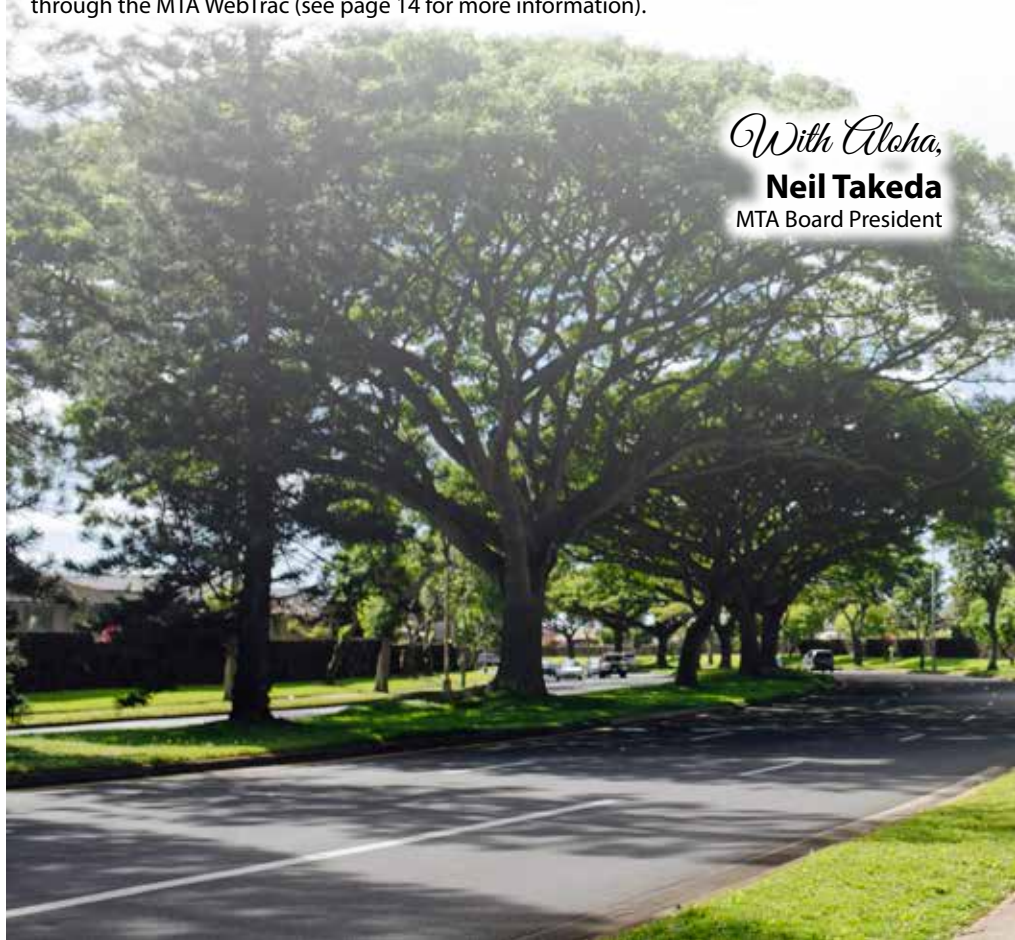

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A Message From SENATOR MICHELLE KIDANI

As the 2026 Legislative Session officially comes to a close, I wanted to share several key initiatives that I was proud to help pass this year. If signed into law, these measures have the potential to bring meaningful improvements to Hawai'i's working families, students, and communities.

One important measure passed by the Legislature this session was **SB3125 SD1 HD1 CD2**, which preserves the income tax cuts enacted in 2024 for joint filers earning under \$350,000, heads of household earning under \$262,500, and single filers earning under \$175,000. This measure continues to provide critical financial relief for working and middle-income households across Hawai'i. I strongly believe tax relief intended for ALICE families should go directly into the pockets of those families without requiring them to wait an entire year to receive those benefits. Other meaningful measures advanced this session include **SB2613 SD1 HD3 CD1**, which revises tax map key numbers and streamlines the conveyance process for properties transferred to the Department of Education. These changes are intended to improve efficiency and support the long-term management of public-school properties.

In addition, after two years of advocacy on behalf of our veterans, **SB2614 HD2** was advanced to authorize the Department of Education to award high school diplomas to qualified individuals whose education was interrupted by military service or wartime circumstances during World War II, the Korean War, or the Vietnam War. This significant measure honors the sacrifices made by these individuals and their families by recognizing the educational opportunities they were unable to complete while serving our country.

HB1800 HD1 SD1 CD1, relating to the state budget, includes significant funding to advance key priorities within the Department of Education. These targeted investments will support innovative learning opportunities, strengthen connections between schools and local communities, and improve educational infrastructure statewide.

Key Department of Education investments include:

- Increasing Teacher Housing Revolving Fund ceiling by \$500,000 for teacher housing cottage repairs
- Increasing Education Design and Construction Project Assessment Revolving Fund ceiling by \$7,000,000 for architectural and engineering services to support CIP and deferred maintenance
- Adding 26.00 permanent positions and \$1,065,640 for Regional Kitchen operations
- Adding \$675,000 for the Community School for Adults statewide
- Adding 1.00 permanent Civil Rights Compliance Specialist for Title IX Athletics
- Adding \$1,500,000 for library security services
- Adding 2.00 permanent positions for Hawai'i Early Childhood State Plan
- Adding 1.00 permanent Evaluation Specialist II for Early Learning System Coordination

Additional statewide education investments include:

- \$20 million to support pre-kindergarten expansion
- Total of \$446 million for improvements and repairs to school facilities statewide, including:
 - \$101 million for deferred maintenance
 - \$85 million for health and safety
 - \$21 million to address compliance statewide
 - \$10 million in project completion funds

- \$81 million for support facilities
- \$8 million for kitchen renovations

Beyond the work at the Capitol, I also participated in several meaningful community events throughout our district. One highlight was attending the *Nourishing Hawai'i Future Means of Agreement Signing Ceremony* held in May at Mililani High School. This important initiative reflects Hawai'i's commitment to strengthening food security by increasing the use of locally grown produce in our school meals. By investing in large-scale food manufacturing and distribution systems, we can better connect local farmers and agricultural producers directly to our schools.

Earlier this year, I was deeply honored to be recognized at a Mililani Town Association Board meeting for years of service on the Board of Directors. Since 1995, I have had the privilege of serving our community through Hawai'i's largest homeowners association, helping guide policies and decisions that impact our 27,000+ residents in Mililani. As a long-serving board member and in my role as Director of the Board, I am grateful and appreciate the opportunity to contribute to the strategic planning and oversight of programs, recreation facilities, and neighborhood services that make Mililani such a special place to live. Mahalo to the Association and my fellow board members for the recognition, and the residents of our community for the support and partnership throughout the years. It has been a privilege to serve on our Board!

Although this year's Legislative Session has officially concluded, the work of serving our community continues year-round. Throughout the summer months, I remain committed to advancing meaningful progress in public education, supporting opportunities for our students and families, preserving and celebrating our local culture, and strengthening the communities we call home. Mahalo Mililani Town for staying engaged, informed, and involved. Your continued support and partnership of our Association are deeply appreciated. A Message From SENATOR DONOVAN M. DELA CRUZ

Aloha Mililani Residents,

The 2026 legislative session has just wrapped up and I am excited to bring you legislative updates impacting the Mililani community! This session focused on strengthening public infrastructure, supporting education, and protecting our working families.

Investing in Community Spaces for the Future

The State Budget, through HB1800, secured funding for plans and designs to renovate the Mililani Library, an important investment in one of Central Oahu's most utilized community resources. These improvements will help modernize the facility, address long-term maintenance needs, and enhance the library experience for students, families, seniors, and residents who rely on the library for educational programs, internet access, workforce development, and community gathering space. Funding for the planning and design phase is a critical first step toward future renovations that will ensure the Mililani Library continues to serve the growing needs of our community for years to come.

Additionally, funding was also allocated to building a covered play court at Mililani High School, creating a new space for athletics, community events and farmers markets. The covered play court will allow a shaded area that can be utilized year-round for our community.

Protecting Tax Breaks for our Working Families

The Legislature kept its promise by protecting the tax breaks made in [Act 46, Session Laws of Hawaii 2024](#), which provides meaningful tax relief for the working and middle-income families of Hawai'i.

Despite federal funding uncertainties and revenue pressures, the Legislature maintained its commitment by tightening spending while balancing the state budget and protecting essential services.

With agreement on SB3125, lawmakers ensured that income tax cuts remain in place for approximately 90% of Hawai'i's households, allowing families to keep more of what they earn. This was done by preserving tax breaks for families earning an adjusted gross income of \$350,000 and below for joint filers, \$262,500 and below for heads of household, and \$175,000 and below for individual filers. The legislature further enhanced these tax cuts by further decreasing taxes on the two lowest brackets in 2027 and 2029 which further decreases taxes for all filers

The core principle of the Senate's tax proposal was simple: relief should be automatic, reliable, and felt throughout the year – not burdening working families to claim credits at the end of each tax year. Families will feel the benefit day to day, paycheck to paycheck without having to file for tax credits or waiting till the end of the year for a refund.

While tax breaks were protected, the State restructured long standing tax credits for certain industries such as solar and renewable fuels. By establishing sunset dates and phased eliminations, the Legislature has created a structure that allows for periodic evaluation, transparency, and accountability. Over time, many tax credits have grown costly without sufficient review or clear evidence that they are delivering meaningful returns to our communities. This provides the Legislature a chance to review them to ensure they are meeting our state goals.


A Message From REPRESENTATIVE LAUREN CHEAPE MATSUMOTO

The 2026 Hawai'i State Legislative Session has officially ended, and I want to take a moment to share an update on the work we've accomplished together this year. This session was marked by thoughtful discussion, strong community engagement, and meaningful progress on issues that matter most to our residents. It has been an honor to represent you in the State House and to carry your voices into these important conversations. I am especially grateful to everyone who took the time to stay involved—whether by completing my Mid-Session Survey, attending community meetings, reaching out with your concerns, or simply sharing your mana'o on how we can move Hawai'i forward. Your input continues to shape the work we do, and I truly appreciate your partnership in building a stronger future for our communities.

I am very excited to announce that the Individual Housing Account bill, SB 2552, has passed! For the past five years, I have worked alongside fellow legislators to modernize the Individual Housing Account program. Originally established in 1982, the program has been underutilized in recent years due to outdated savings limits. This initiative helps individuals and families save quicker for a down payment by allowing pre-tax income to be deposited into a dedicated housing account, up to \$20,000 annually for individuals and \$40,000 for joint filers. The updated legislation also raises the total account cap from \$25,000 to \$200,000, making it a far more effective tool for achieving homeownership. I am thrilled that Hawai'i families now have a way to save up for down payments faster and with fewer financial burdens in today's high-cost housing market.

Additionally, if you're a first-time home buyer, you may qualify for the Hale Kama'aina Program! Originally known as the Hula Mae Program, the Hale Kama'aina Program has resurrected and modernized the State's first-time homebuyer mortgage assistance efforts to better meet today's housing affordability challenges in Hawai'i. This is a program that I have been working on for the last 12 years and I am excited to announce the program has gone into effect last December and the first participants just closed on their

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home. First-time homebuyers may apply for the program through participating lenders. Once your application has been approved, the participating lender will then process the application and conduct a closing for your home if you are approved. The Hale Kama'aina Program offers a 30-year fixed mortgage at an interest rate below market and can include optional down payment assistance. Take advantage of this amazing program and learn more by going to <https://dbedt.hawaii.gov/hhfdc/hk-mortgage-program/>. This program is especially meaningful to me, as it is similar to the Hula Mae program that played a direct role in helping my family afford our home. It's a resource that truly makes homeownership more attainable for local families, and I appreciate the impact it continues to have in our community.

Finally, I want to extend a heartfelt mahalo to everyone who took the time to complete and submit responses to my Mid-Session Survey. I deeply appreciate your willingness to share your thoughts, experiences, and priorities with me. Your voice plays an essential role in guiding my work at the Legislature, helping to shape the policies and legislation I advocate for, and ensuring that I remain grounded in the real needs of our community. Feedback like yours provides an important window into the challenges families are facing as well as the opportunities we can work toward together. Now that the 2026 legislative session is done, roughly 300 bills passed during the 2026 legislative session. A Message From REPRESENTATIVE TRISH LA CHICA

Dear Mililani Neighbors,

Mahalo once again for the opportunity to serve our community as your State Representative for District 37.

As Assistant Majority Floor Leader and Vice Chair of the House Education Committee, I continued advocating for community-centered solutions focused on public safety, education, transportation, and supporting working families.

2026 Legislative Session Highlights

This session, I introduced 23 bills and 6 resolutions, many shaped directly by feedback from the more than 660+ households who responded to our legislative surveys. Here are some notable highlights, all awaiting Governor's signature:

• HB1785 – School Bus Contracting Flexibility

This would give the Department of Education faster authority to act when school bus contractors fail to provide service for five or more consecutive days, helping prevent prolonged disruptions that leave students stranded without reliable transportation to school.

• SB3001 – Artificial Intelligence Disclosure and Safety Act

As AI chatbots like ChatGPT and Meta AI become more common,

this law requires companies to disclose when someone is interacting with artificial intelligence instead of a real person and creates stronger protections for minors. After reports nationwide linked emotionally manipulative AI chatbot interactions to mental health crises and suicides among youth, I strongly championed this measure and fought to ensure there were no loopholes weakening protections for children and families.

Bills I Will Continue Fighting For

Although these measures did not pass this year, I plan to continue pushing for:

- A public charter school pilot for Koa Ridge (HB1783)
- Free weekend access to school playgrounds and courts (HB1786)
- Universal free school meals for DOE students (HB1779)
- Free bus passes for low-income students (HB1780)
- Stronger pedestrian and crosswalk safety protections (HB2186)
- Expedited Safe Routes to School projects (HB1499)
- Protecting residents from medical debt reporting (HB2187)

Investments for Our District

I am so grateful to have worked with the Legislature to secure more than \$46.7 million in capital improvements for Central Oahu:

- **\$20.45M for Roads and Highways:** new safety barriers and signage along Kamehameha Highway near Kipapa Gulch Bridge, and Kamehameha Highway repaving improvements between Mililani and Pearl City, including from Ka Uka Blvd. to Waipahu St.
- **Schools and Early Learning:**
\$11.5M for public school improvements, including:
 - A new kindergarten playground at Mililani Waena Elementary
 - Parking lot resurfacing at Kanoelani Elementary
 - Kitchen renovations across the Leilehua-Mililani-Waialua complex
 - New covered play courts at Mililani High School

Two new public pre-kindergarten classrooms serving our area are also being added at Lihua Elementary School and Mililani Mauka Elementary School through the State's Executive Office on Early Learning (EOEL) program, which provides free public pre-K opportunities for qualifying families.

- Other Major Investments
 - \$1.25M for improvements at the Mililani Public Library
 - \$9.5M for UH West O'ahu campus modernization
 - \$4M for critical wastewater repairs at Waiawa Correctional Facility
 - \$1.55M in Grant-in-Aid funding supporting community organizations serving Central O'ahu families including Cohen Clinic at Endeavors Mililani, Impact Change – Building Blocks Hawai'i, the Wahiawā Center for Community Health, the Hawai'i United Okinawa Association, and Transforming Communities with Aloha.

Community Safety and Constituent Services

Over the past three years, I've continued working closely with residents and state and city agencies to improve safety, maintenance, and quality of life throughout our community. This year's progress included:

- New speed tables near Meheula Parkway and H-2 ramps
- Traffic signal timing and crosswalk improvements at key intersections
- Continued graffiti and illegal dumping cleanup efforts
- Grass cutting along Kamehameha Highway
- Playground safety and equipment repairs
- Removal of abandoned vehicles and debris
- Ongoing restoration work in Kipapa Gulch including highway fence replacement and rock debris removal

My office also responded to more than 260 constituent requests this year involving traffic concerns, homeless encampments,

feral chickens and animals, power outages, helping families navigate immigration concerns, and connecting kupuna with essential services. If you ever need assistance, please email me at replachica@capitol.hawaii.gov or call our office at (808) 586-6150.

Staying Connected

I've continued making it a priority to stay visible, informed, and connected to our community. This year, that included our December Community Talk Story event, regular community surveys, school visits across O'ahu and neighboring islands, a learning tour on agrivoltaics and local agriculture innovation in Central O'ahu, Read Across America classroom visits, and various recognition ceremonies at many school and community events throughout the district.

Now that the legislative session has concluded, I look forward to spending even more time in the community addressing concerns, attending events, and continuing outreach across the district.

A Message From COUNCILMEMBER VAL OKIMOTO

Aloha mai kākou Mililani! I am excited to share some of the meaningful progress and investments happening across District 8. As Budget Chair at the Honolulu City Council, it has been an honor advocating for our communities through this year's City Budget. Along with presenting a balanced and community focused budget we are proud to announce a significant \$148 million investment directly into the infrastructure and safety of our community.

As your Budget Chair, I have prioritized funding that addresses some of our most pressing local needs, including nearly \$100 million to develop affordable housing for local families. As many of you have noticed, road resurfacing efforts have been taking place in Mililani Mauka. The resurfacing work will continue as we have also secured \$40.2 million for major roadway resurfacing across Mililani and \$8 million to modernize our local parks with sustainable lighting and resilient facility upgrades.

On the policy front, we are taking decisive action to improve neighborhood safety and government efficiency. Through Bill 8, we have significantly increased fines for animal nuisances and established a more robust dog bite reporting system to better manage dangerous animals in our community.

Last year, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) updated its Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs), which determine flood zones and high-risk areas. As a result, several neighborhoods in our community were reclassified into FEMA's new proposed flood zone map. Most notably was Waimakua Drive in Waipi'o Acres. The new FIRM maps will become effective on June 10, 2026. To that end, we are streamlining the path for Bill 34, which updates our flood hazard standards to protect property values.

With recent Kona Lows and the start of hurricane season it is crucial that our 'ohana review preparedness plans as well as our property insurance. Standard homeowners' and renters' insurance does NOT cover flooding. Flood insurance covers your home AND your belongings from flooding incidents regardless of the cause, helping you recover faster and more fully after a disaster. It takes 30 days for flood policies to become active, plan ahead to save what you love in a flood!

Through the FY27 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), these proposed investments support safe roads, improved parks, and critical infrastructure upgrades that will strengthen and enhance communities across District 8.

- \$2,500,000 to plan, design, construct and inspect sustainable and resilient capital park improvements, including the replacement of baseball field and pool lights, and provide related park equipment at the Pearl City District Park.
- \$1,000,000 to plan, design, construct and inspect sustainable and resilient capital parking improvements, including the installation of baseball field lights, and provided related park equipment for the Breene Harimoto Manana Community Park and Youth Facility.
- \$4,500,000 to plan, design, construct, inspect, and provide equipment for sustainable and resilient capital park improvements to Crestview Community Park, Mililani District Park, Mililani Mauka Community Park, Mililani Mauka District Park, Pacific Palisades Community Park, and Waiau District Park.
- \$40,200,000 allocated to acquire land, design, construct,

and inspect sustainable roadway and related improvements, including resurfacing on Moanalua Rd. from 'Aiea Access Rd. to Ka'ahumanu St., Meheula Parkway, Lanikuhana Ave., Kipapa Dr., and Kuahelani Ave. in Mililani.

- \$99,800,000 in provisional funds for the acquisition of land and other miscellaneous costs for the purpose of developing, constructing, and providing low- and moderate-income affordable housing, including, but not limited to, housing for teachers and first responders, to address homelessness, and any necessary related infrastructure improvements, which may be undertaken with public agencies or private entities or developers, and which may include the costs of developing, constructing, and providing:
 - Mixed-income housing projects; or
 - Mixed-use projects, which may combine low- and moderate-income affordable housing or mixed-income housing with governmental, educational, commercial, cultural, institutional, or industrial uses, for the purpose of providing such low- and moderate-income affordable housing, to the extent allowed by law.

These budget additions represent a significant investment directly into health, safety, and infrastructure for our beloved communities in District 8. From revitalizing our local parks and roads, to securing affordable housing for our workforce, we are ensuring District 8 remains a safe and exciting place to live and raise our 'ohana. Mahalo for your continued trust and partnership. As your Councilmember, I remain committed to serving District 8 and look forward to continuing our work together in the year ahead.

The MTA quarterly assessment is collected in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.02 of the Mililani Town DCCR. **Assessment due dates are January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st in the amount of \$165.00 per quarter (effective April 1, 2025).** Quarterly reminder notices are sent to homeowners. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of the month that payment is due

1. **SUREPAY PAYMENT PLAN** - SurePay allows your bank to automatically, electronically transfer your quarterly assessment payments from your checking or savings account through Automated Clearing House (ACH) to MTA. 2. **PAY ONLINE** - To safely pay your assessment online, homeowners must go through the official MTA website (www.mililantown.org). 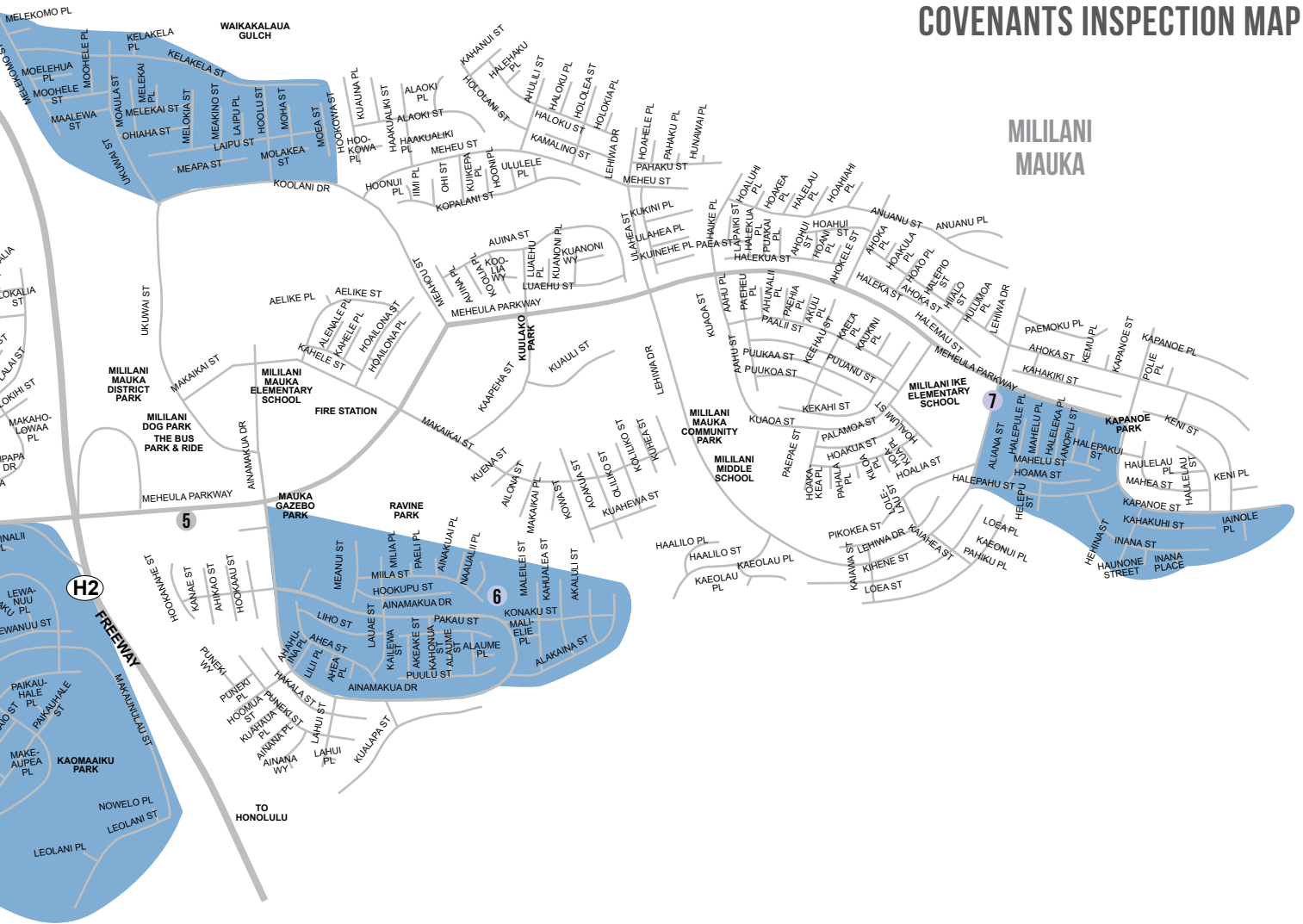
