Aloha e Mililani 'Ohana,

A Greener Mililani—and Beyond

Will's message in last month's MTA newsletter was a great reminder of how every little step helps to protect and preserve Hawai'i's natural resources and island ecosystem. Coincidentally, that message lined up perfectly with a project a couple of my coworkers and I took on at the end of July.

Because our Hawai'i team is completely home-based, we wanted a good excuse to finally meet face-to-face. A volunteer day seemed like the perfect answer—a chance to get out of the house, catch up in person, and give back to the islands we love. We ended up partnering with a coastal restoration program on the North Shore, where our focus was nurturing and cultivating over 300 native starter plants and seedlings. It was fascinating to learn that once these native plants are rooted along the coast, they do the heavy lifting of building up sand dunes, stopping erosion, and protecting our fragile shorelines.

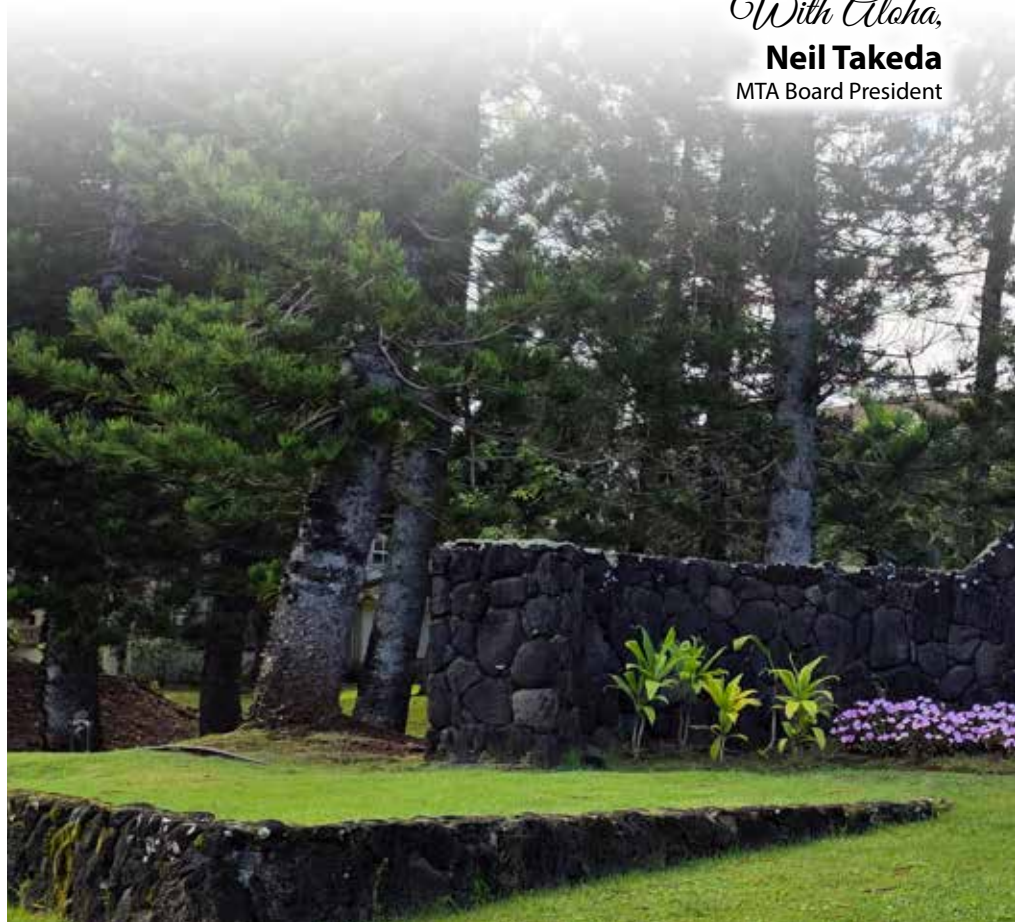
We worked through a classic hot and humid Friday from morning into the early afternoon. At first, our conversation centered entirely on the sticky, hot weather and teasing whoever was taking the longer water breaks! But we quickly moved past that and had an awesome time, sharing stories. The highlight came during a late lunch at a North Shore restaurant. Since we had just spent the day working side-by-side, sitting down together didn't feel like a standard work lunch at all—it truly felt like a gathering of old friends.

I'll always treasure that day for the amazing fellowship but knowing that our hands helped make a lasting difference for Hawai'i makes it even more special. There are many organizations out there, looking for an extra pair of hands, and volunteering doesn't cost a thing. Make it a day to connect with friends and families while making a difference to help protect Hawai'i for future generations. If you don't like driving across the island, there are plenty of small ways we can pitch in, right here in our own backyards to keep our community thriving.

HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS

The MTA quarterly assessment is collected in accordance with Article VI, Section 6.02 of the Mililani Town DCCR. **Assessment due dates are January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st in the amount of \$165.00 per quarter (effective April 1, 2025).** Quarterly reminder notices are sent to homeowners. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of the month that payment is due

5 WAYS TO PAY YOUR HOMEOWNER ASSESSMENTS:

1. **SUREPAY PAYMENT PLAN** - SurePay allows your bank to automatically, electronically transfer your quarterly assessment payments from your checking or savings account through Automated Clearing House (ACH) to MTA. Fill out a SurePay form and turn it in to one of our business offices or send it to surepay@mililantown.org. Submit a voided check with your form.

2. **PAY ONLINE** - To safely pay your assessment online, homeowners must go through the official MTA website (www.mililantown.org). Once on the official MTA home page, click on "Pay Assessments" in the top menu bar and you will be directed to the online payment page. Payments made through any other website is not recommended and are not guaranteed by MTA.
3. **PAY IN PERSON** - Payments may be made at the Admin Office, Rec 3 or Rec 7 Business Office during their regular business office hours. Please bring your remittance stub with you when you make your payment.
4. **USE OUR SECURE DROP-BOX** - There is a secure drop-box located inside the Admin Office and is only available during regular business hours.
5. **PAY BY MAIL** - To avoid late fees, please allow ample time for mail delivery and for your payments to post as received. Homeowners with multiple properties must submit a separate remittance stub and payment, for each property address.
 - If you are mailing a check with the remittance stub, please mail it to: Mililani Town Association, P.O. Box 29380, Honolulu, HI 96820-1780. This is a "Lockbox" service through Bank of Hawaii. Only the payment will be processed.
 - If you are mailing a check without the remittance stub or with the remittance stub and other correspondence or enclosures (such as name or mailing address changes), please mail it to:

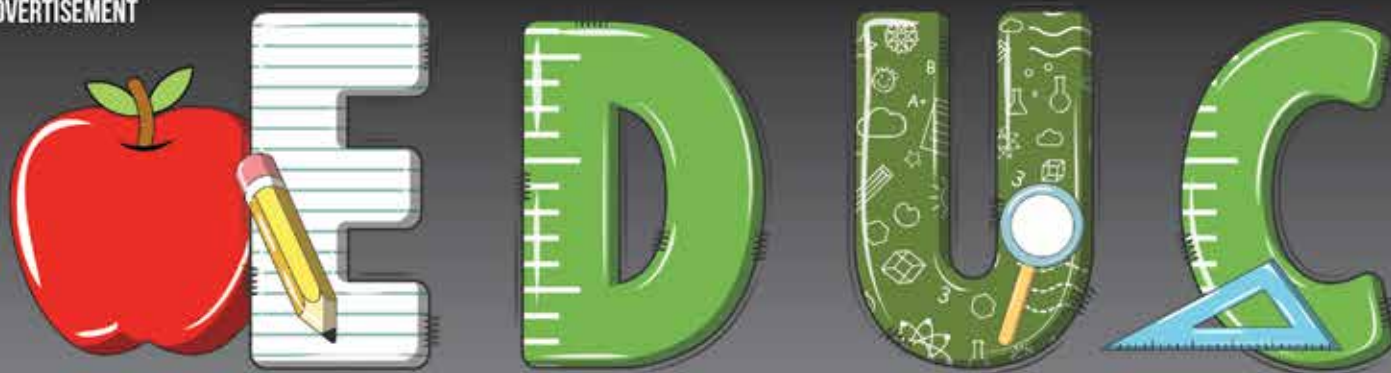

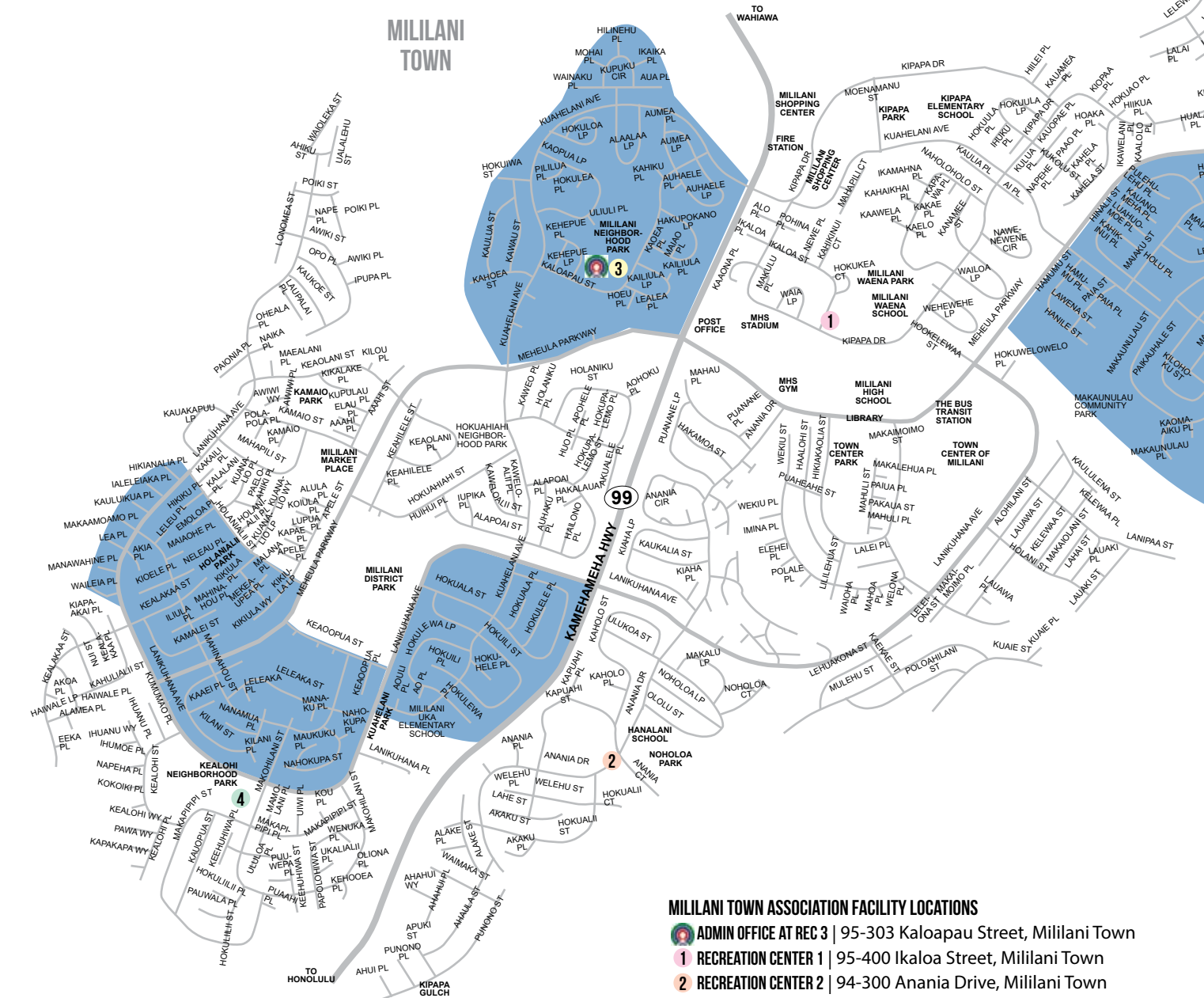

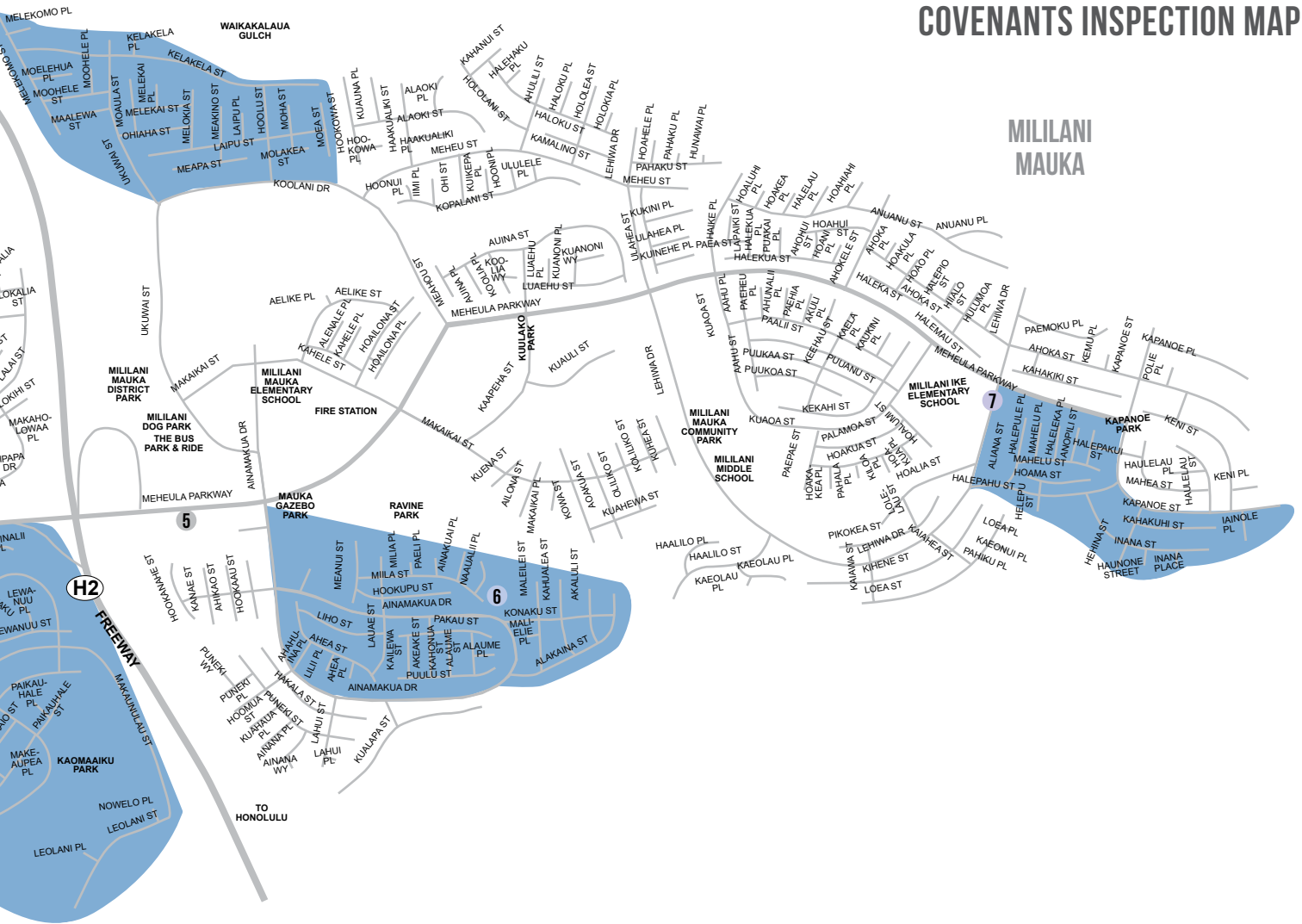

1. Take stock.

- The value of personal property, including art, cars, jewelry, and real estate
- Bank, brokerage, and retirement account statements
- Insurance policies

3. Put your plan into action.

Your estate attorney will craft a plan that likely consists of:

- Medical and financial powers of attorney to designate who will make health care and financial decisions, respectively, if you can't.
- Trust documents that dictate criteria for asset distribution to your beneficiaries.

Your attorney and financial advisor may also work in tandem to ensure your asset titling and beneficiary designations are current.

4. Review your plan regularly.

Estate planning is not a one-and-done task. Revisit your plan regularly so that it continues to reflect your wishes—particularly after significant life events.
